IGC POSITION: \$1,390 over-recovery, including interest.

ISSUE 2: What are the actual/estimated conservation cost recovery true-up amounts for the period January 2008 through December 2008?

IGC POSITION: \$21,610 over-recovery.

ISSUE 3: What are the total conservation cost recovery amounts to be collected during the period January 2009 through December 2009?

IGC POSITION: \$7,378 to be recovered during January 2009 through December 2009.

ISSUE 4: What are the conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2009 through December 2009?

IGC POSITION: The appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for Indiantown Gas Company for the period January 2009 through December 2009 are as follows:

TS-4	\$0.00087

ISSUE 5: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

IGC POSITION: The Company's conservation cost recovery factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and remain in effect thereafter for the period January 2009 through December 2009.

As of the filing of this Prehearing Statement, Indiantown Gas Company does not intend to use confidential documents at hearing.


J. OBJECTIONS TO QUALIFICATIONS OF WITNESSES
