Dear Mr. Olivera:

In response to your November 17, 2008, test year notification letter, Docket No. 080677-EI has been opened for Florida Power & Light Company's (Company) forthcoming general rate increase proceeding. It has been noted that the Company proposes to utilize a projected twelve-month period ending December 31, 2010, as the test year for the permanent rate increase proceeding. In addition, the Company is proposing a subsequent year adjustment based on a projected twelve-month period ending December 31, 2011. However, the appropriateness of the selected test years may be an issue in the proceeding.

It is my understanding that the Company intends to make its filing during the month of March 2009. Therefore, the Minimum Filing Requirements and associated testimony will be due at the Commission's offices no earlier than January 16, 2009, and no later than March 31, 2009. If the Company is unable to file within that time period, it must notify the Commission in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-7.140(3), Florida Administrative Code.
