#### PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION AND MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

Peoples Gas System ("Peoples" or the "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, *Florida Statutes*, and Rule 25-22.006, *Florida Administrative Code*, hereby requests confidential classification of (and the issuance of a temporary protective order with respect to) the document(s) printed on yellow paper and the yellow highlighted information contained in the following described document(s) (the "Document(s)") stamped "CONFIDENTIAL", which are submitted herewith, all of said confidential information being hereinafter referred to as "Confidential Information."

#### Description of the Document(s)

The Documents consist audit workpapers pursuant to Audit Control No. 08-234-2-2. In support of its request, Peoples states:

1. Subsection 366.093(1), *Florida Statutes*, provides that any records "found by the Commission to be proprietary confidential business information shall be kept confidential and shall be exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes [requiring disclosure under the Public Records Act]." The Confidential Information that is the subject of this request and motion falls within the statutory categories, and thus constitutes proprietary confidential business information entitled to protection under Section 366.093, *Florida Statutes*, and Rule 25-22.006, *Florida Administrative Code*.

2. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is justification for confidential treatment of the Confidential Information contained in the Documents.

3. The Confidential Information contained in the Documents is intended to be and is treated by Peoples as private and has not been publicly disclosed.

4. For the same reasons set forth herein in support of its request for confidential classification, Peoples also moves the Commission for entry of a temporary protective order pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), *Florida Administrative Code*, protecting the Confidential Information from public disclosure.

#### **Requested Duration of Confidential Classification**

5. Peoples requests that the Confidential Information be treated by the Commission as confidential proprietary business information for at least the 18 month period prescribed in Rule 25-22.006(9)(a), *Florida Administrative Code*. If, and to the extent that the Company is in need of confidential classification of the Confidential Information beyond the 18 month period set forth in the Commission rule, the justification and grounds for such extended period of confidential treatment are set forth in Exhibit "C" to this request and motion.

WHEREFORE, Peoples Gas System respectfully requests that the Confidential Information that is the subject of this request and motion be accorded confidential classification for the reasons set forth herein and for a minimum period of 18 months,

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subject to any request for a longer period of confidential classification as may be set forth in Exhibit "C" to this request and motion. The Company further moves for the entry of a temporary protective order pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), *Florida Administrative Code*, protecting the Confidential Information from public disclosure.
