FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided to the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") staff ("Staff") in connection with Staff's Review of Florida Power & Light's Quality Assurance Process for Distribution Construction. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. By letter dated November 26, 2008, Staff provided FPL with a draft copy of its report (the "Report") entitled *Florida Power & Light's Quality Assurance Process for Distribution Construction.* In that letter Staff indicated its intent to publish the Report as soon as possible after the 21 day filing period which expires on December 19, 2008. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3), Florida Administrative Code, FPL was given 21 days from the date of that letter, or until December 19, 2008, to file a formal request for confidential classification with respect to the Report. This Request is being filed pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a).
 - 2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
 - a. Exhibit A consists of copies of specified pages of the Report (pages 12, 14, 16, 18 and 19), on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Composite Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked "CONFIDENTIAL."

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- b. Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Exhibit A on which all information FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing a line-by-line and page-by-page identification of the information for which confidential classification is sought, and, with regard to each document or portions thereof, references to the specific statutory basis or bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.
 - d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Robert Onsgard.
- 3. FPL seeks confidential treatment of the information highlighted in Exhibit A. The highlighted information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes, specifically including but not limited to Section 366.093(3)(b). The information is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as confidential.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, the information highlighted in Exhibit A is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review, such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 5. As the affidavit in Exhibit D indicates, the highlighted information consists of information from internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors and references to confidential audits and underwriting risk assessments. This auditing information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(b), Florida Statutes.
- 6. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A and referenced in Exhibit C is proprietary confidential business information, the information

should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that this Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
