In follow up to the request for abeyance forwarded November, 2008, I would like to take this opportunity to update the Public Service Commission as to the current status of the purchase of Holiday Utility Company, Inc. by the Florida Governmental Utility Authority (FGUA), of which Pasco County is a member.

The due diligence regarding Holiday Utility is in final stage at this time. Currently FGUA is completing due diligence regarding acquisition of the Holiday system and all is looking positive for an acquisition to be finalized. In speaking with the FGUA representatives, it appears that we are on schedule for probable transfer of ownership as early as May and as late as July. As we have mentioned in the past, the FGUA acquisition of the Holiday Utility System will eliminate the related territory issue and need for the docket to remain open.
