# PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF GPIF RESULTS FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 2008

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") hereby Petitions this Commission for approval of a Generating Performance Incentive Factor ("GPIF") reward of \$11,464,340 for the period ending December 2008. In support of this Petition, FPL states as follows:

By Order No. PSC-08-0030-FOF-EI dated January 8, 2008, the Commission approved GPIF Targets for FPL for the period January 2008 through December 2008. The application of the GPIF formula to FPL's performance during that period produces a reward of \$11,464,340. The calculation of FPL's GPIF reward is discussed and supported in the prepared testimony of FPL witness Roxane R. Kennedy, which is being filed with and incorporated in this Petition. WHEREFORE, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests the Commission to approve \$11,464,340 as FPL's GPIF reward for the period ending December 2008 and include

this amount in the calculation of the FCR Factor for the period beginning January 2010.
