On September 14, 2007, Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF") filed a Request for Confidential Classification ("Request") in Docket No. 070001-El concerning certain information provided in response to OPC's Second Request for Production of Documents (2-16). Those confidential materials are designated by the Commission as Document No. 08362-07, and the Request itself is Document No. 08361-07.
