The starting time of the next day's session will be announced at the conclusion of the prior day. The hearing may be adjourned early if all testimony is concluded.

To become an official party of record, you must file a Petition for Intervention at least five days before the final hearing, pursuant to the requirements contained in Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the above-noted petitions of Florida Power & Light Company (FPL), and determine the appropriate underground residential distribution (URD) tariffs, and the appropriate underground conversion contributions in aid of construction (CIAC) charges, and what is the appropriate relief if the Commission determines that the temporary charges allowed were too high. Also, the Commission will consider any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on May 18, 2009. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

EMERGENCY CANCELLATION OF HEARING

If settlement of the case or a named storm or other disaster requires cancellation of the hearing, Commission staff will attempt to give timely direct notice to the parties.
