Dear Chairman Carter.

I wanted to provide you a brief update on the water pilot project that Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. ("AUF") is currently implementing in our Chuluota water system. AUF has committed to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") to perform the pilot work and proceed with installation of additional treatment to improve water quality in Chuluota.

On the advice of Dr. Taylor, AUF is testing two water treatment processes at the Chuluota Water Treatment Plant #2. The Thermax Ion exchange unit was installed at Chuluota on March 25, 2009. The Adedge filtration system was installed at Chuluota on April 15, 2009. Both the Adedge and Thermax processes are designed to improve the quality of the Chuluota water, particularly by removing hydrogen sulfide more efficiently than the tray aerators that are now in place. None of the water that is utilized in the pilot project enters the Chuluota water system. After the pilot project is complete, AUF will initiate planning and construction of one of the treatment processes in accordance with the timelines set forth in the FDEP consent order.

We understand that some customers have observed an increased level of activity at the water treatment plant #2 and have contacted the FDEP with questions. AUF has been updating the FDEP regularly and is giving FDEP a tour of the pilot processes in the upcoming weeks.

Some customers have expressed questions about the pilot project, and in particular the regeneration and backwashing processes. These are treatment operation functions that periodically clean and restore the filters. The water that that is used to clean the media is collected and stored on site into a tank mounted on a trailer. Once the storage tank contains approximately 400 gallons of backwash water it is then discharged to the sewer system to be treated at our wastewater treatment facility. There is no wastewater service line presently at the Water Plant #2 site. Thus, the wastewater

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needs to be physically transported. Backwash water from the pilots has been trucked twice since the pilot work started in March. The backwash water is treated at our wastewater treatment facility. All wastewater is being disposed in accordance with FDEP guidelines.
