Dear Mr. Suchora:

Thank you for your letter dated May 26, 2009, in which you expressed your concerns regarding the Commission's approval of an increase in water and wastewater rates for Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. in Docket No. 070694-WS. As you know, the Commission voted to approve the utility's rate increase on December 12, 2008. This decision was memorialized in Order No. PSC-08-0827-PAA-WS which became final on January 20, 2009.

In the instant case, Docket No. 090232-WS pertains to the joint application for authority to transfer the utilities assets and Certificates in Orange County from Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. to Pluris Wedgefield, LLC. As such, please be advised that this docket will not address the previously approved rate increase. Moreover, no other rate issues will be analyzed in this docket. I hope that this information clarifies the subject matter of Docket No. 090232-WS and addresses your concerns.

Before taking any further actions with respect to your letter, the Commission must know your intent regarding your objection to the above referenced transfer in this docket. If you choose to pursue this protest, you will have certain rights and responsibilities to put on your case, including filing written testimony, participating in motion practice and formal discovery, filing a prehearing statement, attending a prehearing to be held in Tallahassee, Florida, putting on witnesses and cross-examining utility and other witnesses at the hearing, and filing a post-hearing brief. All of these activities will have due dates that will be required to be met by all parties to this proceeding. Although utility customers may represent themselves at formal hearings before the Florida Public Service Commission, it may be preferable to hire counsel or a qualified representative to represent you.

That being said, if you do not wish to pursue a formal hearing, your letter will be placed in the correspondence side of the docket file in this case, where your concerns will remain available for review and informational purposes. Additionally, upon your request, we can send you a copy of staff's recommendation and you may address the Commissioners at the Agenda Conference.

If you wish to initiate a protest proceeding in the above referenced docket, please submit to the Office of Commission Clerk of the Florida Public Service Commission a written petition initiating formal proceedings in accordance with the requirements of Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, by **Tuesday, June 16**, **2009**. Your petition should be made in writing and should be addressed to the Florida Public Service Commission, Director, Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. If we do not hear from you by **Tuesday, June 16**, **2009**, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue a formal hearing and your letter will be placed in the correspondence side of the docket file in the above referenced matter.

Thank you for the assurances provided in your response regarding certificates and the emergency contact information. I must point out that the docket information included an emergency contact telephone number, which when tested, was in fact not an emergency contact number.

Based on the assurances you provided about the availability of the orders indicated, and assuming an agreement that Wedgfield Pluris LLC shall provide, upon completing the purchase, a staffed emergency phone line with 24 hours a day, 7 days a week service coverage that shall also include rapid dispatch, within 30 - 45 minutes of the customer's emergency call, of a qualified water plant technician to the water plant site to provide emergency corrective response, I have no objections to the planned purchase / sale.

My intent is to assure a staffed emergency response system is maintained after the sale, since there have been many alarms sounded at the facility in the recent past which were promptly attended to by the staff located within the community.

Dear Mr. Mike Dydo:

Thank you for your letter dated May 18, 2009, in which you expressed your concerns regarding the absence of physical certificates for review by customers as well as the apparent non-existence of any emergency contact number at the utility. Please be advised that the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) no longer issues actual Certificates to Water and Wastewater utilities. Rather, the Commission orders serve as the certificate for the utility. Moreover, the Commission is in the process of modifying rules to delete the requirement to submit certificates as that requirement is now obsolete. For example, if the circumstances in the instant case merit approval of the transfer of Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. the Commission order itself approving the transfer will serve as Pluris Wedgefield LLC's (Pluris) water and/or wastewater certificate. As you know, all recommendations and orders of the Commission are accessible via the Commission's web site located at http://www.psc.state.fl.us/.

With respect to your concern regarding the non-existence of an emergency contact number, as this matter is still pending before the Commission, Pluris has not yet taken over ownership of the utility and thus, has not yet established a twenty-four hour emergency hotline. However, please be

advised that Commission staff has confirmed with representatives of Pluris that if the transfer in the above-referenced docket is approved, Pluris will ensure that an emergency contact line is available to all of its customers twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

Before taking any further actions with respect to your letter, the Commission must know your intent regarding your objection to the above referenced transfer in this docket. If you choose to pursue this protest, you will have certain rights and responsibilities to put on your case, including filing written testimony, participating in motion practice and formal discovery, filing a prehearing statement, attending a prehearing to he held in Tallahassee, Florida, putting on witnesses and crossexamining utility and other witnesses at the hearing, and filing a post-hearing brief. All of these activities will have due dates that will be required to be met by all parties to this proceeding. Although utility customers may represent themselves at formal hearings before the Florida Public Service Commission, it may be preferable to hire counsel or a qualified representative to represent you.

That being said, if you do not wish to pursue a formal hearing, your letter will be placed in the correspondence side of the docket file in this case, where your concerns will remain available for review and informational purposes. Additionally, upon your request, we can send you a copy of staff's recommendation and you may address the Commissioners at the Agenda Conference.
