In my March 19, 2009, response to your March 13, 2009, test year notification letter, I indicated that Docket No. 090125-GU had been opened for The Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation's (Company) forthcoming general rate increase proceeding and I noted the Company intended to file its petition for a general rate proceeding by May 15, 2009.

On May 15, 2009, the Company notified the Commission that it is seeking an extension of the filing date to June 30, 2009. In accordance with Rule 25-7.140, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the Minimum Filing Requirements and associated testimony will be due at the Commission's offices by June 30, 2009. If the Company is unable to file by its proposed date, it must notify the Commission in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-7.140(3), F.A.C.
