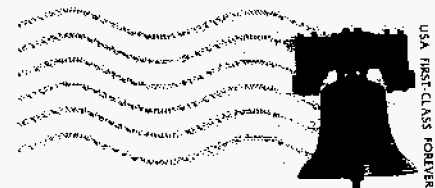

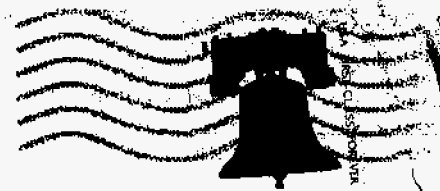

My name is Kay Hicks and I am a resident of Palm Beach Gardens. I attended the hearing held in W. Palm Beach on Wednesday June 24, 2009, but unfortunately had to leave before my turn to speak. This is what I wanted to say:

A few years back, we were on budget billing with FPL and I must admit, I was not watching what my actual usage was for a several months. Out of the blue I received a phone call from a lady who said she worked for FPL and they had noticed that my actual usage amount had increased tremendously over the course of the past 4 months. She wanted to find out what was going and asked me to go through a procedure with her.

After going through the procedure over the phone with her we surmised that the AC unit on our roof was not functioning properly and was the culprit of the huge surge in power usage. Our usage records proved that back a few months prior, we had to call the fire department because we smelled smoke. It was a wire burning in the AC. Our repairman came and patched the problem. This was when the surge in power began.

It led us back to the AC repair company. We then realized that the burned wire was probably caused when the AC covering was peeled off during a storm. We were able to have the AC replaced with the help of our insurance company. Our power bill came back to normal, so thanks go to FPL.

In conclusion, I ask you to support the proposed rate increase for FPL.

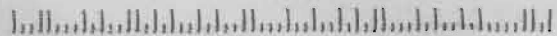

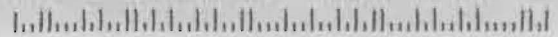

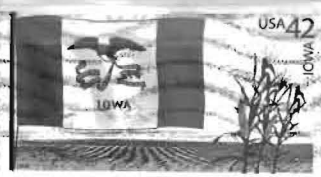
