*Re: Summary of Auburndale Cogeneration Event beginning on June 5, 2009; Undocketed*


Dear Ms. Cole:

Pursuant to FPSC Rule 25-17.086, "Periods During Which Purchases are Not Required", Progress Energy Florida (PEF) is providing notice to the Florida Public Service Commission that non-firm energy sales from the Auburndale Power Partners (APP) cogeneration facility to PEF on the RECK-FPC path were limited beginning on 6/5/09 through 6/22/09 due to lack of Available Transmission Capability (ATC) on the PEF Transmission System.

APP is located in the Tampa Electric Company balancing authority area and ATC on the transmission path RECK-FPC was limited due to transmission constraints in the Central Florida region. PEF continues to monitor this congested area. After updating ATC parameters, PEF released ATC on 6/23/09. Pursuant to PEF's Open Access Transmission Tariff, APP now has a yearly firm transmission reservation (#73181866) for 150 MW through 12/31/2013, APP's contract expiration date.
