Dear Ms. Cole:

On May 5, 2009, the Commission voted to grant an increase in the rates and charges on natural gas service provided by Florida Public Utilities Company effective for meter readings on and after June 4, 2009. Pursuant to that authority, the Company filed revised tariff sheets with the Commission which were approved by the Commission. Also in accordance with that order, the Company notified customers of the increase.

On June 17, 2009, the Office of Public Counsel, on behalf of the Citizens of the State of Florida, filed a Petition protesting the action of the Commission. This Petition is pending.

Section 366.06(4), Florida Statutes, permits the Company to place requested rates into effect subject to refund in the event that a party other than the utility protests the Commission's proposed agency action. Pursuant to Section 366.06(4), Florida Statutes, this is to notify the Commission that the Company has implemented the increases pursuant to the authority of Order No. PSC-09-0375-PAA-GU and intends to continue to collect these rates during the pendancy of the protest proceeding. FPUC agrees to collect these revenues under corporate undertaking subject to refund and requests that the Commission approve this arrangement.
