## Dear Chairman Carter:

By letter dated May 15, 2009, the Company respectfully requested an extension of the date by which the Company was to file its Petition, Testimony, and Minimum Filing Requirements (MFRs). The Company asked for an extension to June 30, 2009, in view of the announced merger with FPU. By letter dated May 27, 2009, you acknowledged our request and indicated that we should file by June 30. The Company was directed to provide the Commission with notice, in accordance with Rule 25-7.140(3), Florida Administrative Code, if it would be unable to meet the June 30, 2009, filing date.

Consistent with the notice requirements set forth in Rule 25-7.140(3), Florida Administrative Code, and your letter of May 27, 2009, the Florida Division respectfully submits this request to extend our petition, MFR, and testimony filing dates to July 15, 2009.

The Company asks for this extension in order to adequately complete its testimony and MFRs. The additional time will also allow for a more thorough internal review of the MFRs and testimony prior to filing. The Company believes that this additional time will ensure that the DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE
