Staff is requesting permission to make an oral modification on the recommendation in Docket 090246-TP at the July 14, 2009, Agenda. There has been a scrivener's error in Issue 3 in the recommendation language regarding whether the docket should be closed.

The recommendation language currently reads " If no person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed agency action files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the order, the order should become final and the docket should remain open. Upon filing of the parties executed interconnection agreement, this docket should be closed administratively."

The correct language should read "If no person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed agency action files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the order, the order should become final and the docket should be closed upon issuance of a Consummating Order."
