Docket No. 080271-EI was opened to monitor the status of joint-ownership discussions associated with Florida Power & Light's (FPL) Turkey Point Units 6 & 7, as directed in Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI.

By Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, the Commission approved a stipulation which states in relevant part: "No later than July 1, 2009, FPL will continue its good faith discussions with FMEA, FMFA, and OUC, and will also commence good faith discussions of joint participation in Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 with JEA and Seminole. FPL will report the status of such ongoing status discussions to the FPSC every quarter thereafter."

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that, by July 1, 2009, FPL has continued or commenced good faith discussions with the parties listed in the Order and with others. FPL's initial report on the status of these discussions is due by October 1, 2009; however, FPL anticipates it will file with the Commission its first report in advance of that date.
