DIRECT SUPPLMENTAL TESTIMONY OF BARRY KENNEDY IN

FLORIDA PUBLIC UTITITIES COMPANY DOCKET NO 080366-GU

IN RE: PETITION OF FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY FOR A NATURAL GAS RATE INCREASE

- Q. Please state your name, affiliation, business address and summarize your academic background and professional experience.
- My name is Barry Kennedy. I am currently the General Manager of South Florida 3 4 for Florida Public Utilities (FPU). My business address is 401 S. Dixie Hwy, West 5 Palm Beach, Florida 33401. I joined FPU as Director of Propane Operations in June 6 of 2004. In November of 2005 I assumed the position of General Manager. In my 7 current position I am responsible for propane and natural gas sales, engineering, customer service and operations for South Florida. My responsibilities include all 8 9 aspects of operating my area including personnel, day to day operations and 10 budgeting. Prior to working at FPU I worked at TECO Peoples Gas for 15 years. I 11 started as the Propane Manager in Orlando and progressed to General Manager of 12 the North Region, Prior to TECO I worked in the propage industry for 18 years in 13 various capacities from service tech to manager. I received my Bachelor of Science 14 in Business from Barry University in 1984.
- Q. Have you testified before the Florida Public Service Commission in previouscases?
- 17 A. No, I participated in rate case preparation and customer meetings as part of rate cases with my previous and current employers but have not testified before the commission.
- 20 Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
- A. I am responsible for discussing our proposed Research and Development costs and
 projected Sales and Marketing Expenses.

1	Q.	Describe how FPU intends to use the lunus requested for Research and
2		Development.
3	A.	Florida Public Utilities is committed to the development of new and more efficient
4		products and technologies for our customers. We are proposing a budget of \$50,000
5		to help fund R&D programs that work to that end.
6		We expect the results to provide enhanced service and reliability to our customers
7		and to increase customer and employee safety. These funds would be used for
8		capital and expense projects outside of any approved natural gas energy
9		conservation program.
10		FPU is looking to invest in programs that enhance the use of natural gas in
11		areas like;
12		Energy Solutions
13		Residential Applications
14		Commercial Buildings
15		Residential and Commercial Energy Efficiency
16		Gas Foodservice Equipment
17		Natural Gas motor fuel
18		We at FPU believe that participation in the development of these kinds of
19		programs is essential to the growth and stability of our industry and our ability to
20		serve our customers.
21	Q.	Why does FPU forecast sales expense to increase?
22	A.	Due to economic conditions and the slowing of the housing market FPU has
23		allowed a reduction in its sales force. With the slowing of the economy we did not

fill some positions that became open due to attrition. We felt it was prudent to make these reductions in response to our financial performance.

Going forward FPU intends to increase our marketing efforts in areas that will provide us with the most opportunity for profitable growth. We intend to increase our efforts to saturate the available market that is on our near our mains. This growth can be more economical as far as construction but is much more labor intensive from a marketing perspective. These efforts will allow FPU to provide potential customers who are on main with access to economical, clean efficient and domestically produced natural gas.

FPU also looks forward to the opportunity to provide the benefit of our R&D dollars to our customers by marketing the technologies that are developed.
