This acknowledges receipt of certification that the subject water distribution system extension has been completed in accordance with the plans and related materials permitted by this agency on Permit Number WD35-0080545-001 dated July 7, 2006 and that the system has passed the pressure and bacteriological tests that were conducted in accordance with the AWWA Standards.

Based on this certification and satisfactory bacteriological results, we are accepting the system for service. Included in this project are:

- a new 2,000-gallon ASME Code horizontal hydropneumatic tank, located southwest of the existing 2,000-gallon hydropneumatic tank, which was removed.
- relocation of the existing hypochlorination facilities to a new chlorination structure located adjacent to the new hydropneumatic tank, with a new chlorine injection point on the new raw water line and associated piping, valves, 2-inch flow meter, controls & appurtenances.

The responsibility for the microbiological quality of the water at the time it ultimately reaches the consumer's meter remains entirely with the utility and/or the owner/operator of the system who should ensure that this quality remains as represented by the bacteriological test results presented. This letter of clearance does not preclude the need for obtaining acceptance by other entities as may be required.



Replacement of the Hydropneumatic Tank, Piping, Valves, & Plumbing

Introduction

The Three Lakes Park Drinking Water Facility (WTF) presently operates under the perview of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). The facility consists of one (1) 4-inch ground water well, a liquid sodium hypochlorite chlorination system for disinfection, and a 2,000 gallon (gross) hydropneumamatic ground storage tank. The Three Lakes Park WTF is classified as a community system.

The facility FDEP permitted design capacity is 0.086 mgd. The maximum daily flow for the preceding 12 months, as reported on the FDEP monthly operating reports, is 0.041 MGD. The average daily flow has been 0.0014 mgd (excluding leaking hydro tank reported flows).

Existing Water System Tank Failure

The existing 2,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank began leaking and upon inspection by a competent utility contractor, it was determined un-repairable. FDEP, Central District Office, Drinking Water Section, was contacted and apprised of the situation. Approval was given to place a temporary hydropneumatic tank into service and take the leaking tank off line. This was accomplished and the WTF is currently operating in this mode.

Proposed Hydropneumatic Tank, Piping, Valves, & Plumbing

The existing 2,000 gallon hydropneumatic tank will be replaced by a 2,000 gallon ASME Code, steet tank with two interior coats of Tinemec 20 white. The proposed tank will be placed on an existing 4" concrete slab adjacent to the existing well location. The proposed tank locations, piping layout and system connections are shown on the attached project plan drawing Sheets 1-4 of 4.

The proposed system will be installed upon approval by the Department and will be completed in two working weeks. The Department will be notified by the owner when the change-over will be done and also upon completion of the change-over. All installation and testing will be completed within 60 days of receipt of approval from the Department.





NOTICE OF PERMIT ISSUANCE

Enclosed is Permit Number WC35-0080545-001 to modify a water plant issued pursuant to Section 403,861(9), Florida Statutes.

The Department()'s proposed agency action shall become final unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department is proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received by the clerk) with:

> Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection Office of General Counsel 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35 Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120,60(3) of the Florida Stanutes must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first.

Under Section 120,60(3) of the Florida Statutes, however, any person who has asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication.

The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person as right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120,569 and 120,57 of the Florido Statutes. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-105,205 of the Florida Administrative Code.

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- (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner: s representative, if any, the Department permit identification number and the county in which the subject matter or activity is located;
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department action;
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department action;
- (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (e) A statement of facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department action;
- (f) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department is action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, Florida Statutes.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department Ds final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation under Section 120,573 of the Florida Statutes is not available for this proceeding.

This action is final and effective on the date filed with the Clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above. Upon the timely filing of a petition this order will not be effective until further order of the Department.

Any party to the order has the right to seek judicial review of the order under Section 120.68 of the Florida Statutes, by the filing of a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with:

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Section 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.
