AFFIDAVIT OF HARLEY L. ROLLINS

I, Harley L. Rollins, declare and say as follows:

1. I am over 18 years of age and am competent to make this declaration. Unless otherwise stated, the statements in this declaration are based on my personal knowledge and belief.

2. I serve as Chief Financial Officer of eLandia International, Inc. ("eLandia"), a position I have held since 2004, and Director of Latin Node, Inc. ("Latin Node"), a position I have held since 2007.

3. I have reviewed the claim by The Honduran Company of Telecommunications ("Hondutel") in the amount of \$4,632,950.92. Hondutel was not a creditor of Latin Node at the time of Latin Node's filing of the Assignment for the Benefit of Creditors pending in this Court under Case No. 08-33495 CA 11 and styled as *In Re: Latin Node, Inc., Assignor. To: Michael Phelan, Assignee* (the "Assignment") and therefore was not scheduled as a creditor as part of the Assignment. Latin Node had negotiated rates with Hondutel which were paid on a weekly basis. Pursuant to an agreement between Latin Node and Hondutel, contractual disputes had to be brought within a certain amount of days from the date of billing and Latin Node was never informed of any disputes or these amounts within the relevant time period.

4. After eLandia made public disclosures with the Securities and Exchange Commission regarding alleged Latin Node FCPA violations in Honduras, Latin Node began to receive revised invoices from Hondutel for fees Latin Node allegedly owed to Hondutel as a

result of prior incorrect billing by Hondutel. I believe this was an attempt to correct the very improprieties which had been publicly disclosed regarding Latin Node payments made in exchange for reducing rates under the interconnection agreement with Hondutel.


5. In addition to disclaiming that these amounts are owed to Hondutel, we believe Hondutel is in possession of certain Latin Node equipment of value which was never returned to Latin Node. Unfortunately, we do not currently have access to the appropriate records to itemize and specifically identify said equipment.

6. Elandia will not be disbursed the \$7,000,000.00 as part of the Assignment as represented by Hondutel in their filing to extend the time for the hearing of the Assignee's pending Motion to close the Assignment. Similarly, Elandia has not received any material amounts in exchange for an agreement to waive its secured position in the Latin Node assets.

7. I declare, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
