### JOINT PETITION TO AMENDED TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT

Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF") and Withlacoochee River Electric Cooperative ("WREC") (collectively, the "Parties") petition the Florida Public Service Commission ("the Commission") to amend the current territorial agreement between PEF and WREC that was approved by the Commission per Order No. PSC-06-0202-PAA-EU on March 14, 2006, for the purposes of boundary modifications in four areas to resolve outstanding issues and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

 PEF and WREC are electric utilities organized under the laws of Florida and are subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Section 366.04(2), F.S.
PEF's principal offices are located in St. Petersburg, Florida. WREC's principal offices are located in Dade City, Florida.

2. All pleadings, notices and other communications in this matter should be served on the undersigned representatives for the Parties.

3. WREC and PEF are parties to a currently effective amended and consolidated territorial agreement delineating their respective territories which was approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-06-0202-PAA-EU, issued March 14, 2006, in Docket No. 040133-EU.

4. The Parties have finalized the transfers of customers pursuant to the above stated Order with the exception of 115 customers located in Pasco County as identified in Exhibit A. DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

Furthermore, 33 customers on Handcart Road in Pasco County will be transferred on September 10, 2009. The Parties recognize that operational constraints and good engineering practices indicate that the area identified in Exhibit A should be served by WREC and, therefore the 115 customers will not be transferred.

5. The Parties have further agreed to boundary modifications in three areas of Pasco County due to operational constraints and potential safety issues. The boundary modifications are shown in Exhibits B-1, B-2, C-1, C-2, D-1 and D-2.

6. The boundary modification in Exhibit B-1 is known as the Lykes Brother's Inc. parcel and is located in Hernando County. Based on operational constraints and potential safety issues that have been identified, the Parties have agreed to modify the boundary as shown in Exhibit B-2. This modification involves the transfer of one customer having four accounts on the parcel identified in Exhibit B-1 from PEF to WREC. The customer has agreed to the transfer.

7. There are two boundary modifications located in Zephyrhills, Pasco County. These customers (Mr. Ammon at 5833 Linwood Lane, Zephyrhills, Pasco County, Florida and Mr. Banks at 5433 Ryals Road, Zephyrhills, Pasco County, Florida) were to be transferred to PEF from WREC pursuant to the amended territorial agreement approved in Order No. PSC-06-0202-PAA-EU, issued March 14, 2006, in Docket No. 040133-EU as shown in Exhibits C-1 and D-1. Due to easement issues and operational constraints, the boundary modifications will result in the service territory and the two customers being in WREC's service territory as shown in Exhibits C-2 and D-2, respectively. The customers are currently being served by WREC and, therefore, no transfers will be required at these locations.

Other than the changes identified above, there are no other proposed changes to the current territorial agreement approved by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition and approve this minor amendment to the current agreement between the Parties to allow the boundary modifications as set forth herein.




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
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
