Section 63.71 Application of Network Telephone Corporation to Discontinue Services

Network Telephone Corporation ("Network Telephone" or "Applicant") hereby seeks authorization pursuant to Section 214 (a) of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended, and 47 C.F.R. §63.71, to discontinue its provision of domestic local and long distance telecommunications services (including intrastate, interstate and international) to end-user customers in Gainesville, Florida. Network Telephone provides services to the affected customers under the name Cavalier Business Communications.

Applicant is considered a non-dominant telecommunications carrier with respect to all of its services, including those affected by the proposed discontinuance. As detailed below, the Applicant currently serves only three customers in the area where it proposes to discontinue service. The Applicant will continue to provide telecommunications services in the remainder of its Florida service territory and in a number of other states not affected by this Application.

Network Telephone individually notified affected customers of its proposed discontinuance of service via letter sent first class mail on October 9, 2009.

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance, Reduction or Impairment:

Network Telephone proposes to discontinue service to the affected customers on November 15, 2009.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

Applicant proposes to discontinue the provision of all local and long distance services (including

intrastate, interstate and international) to customers in the Gainesville, Florida exchange.

4. Brief Description of Types of Service Affected:

Network Telephone will discontinue both retail local and long distance service, including voice and data services. Three business customers will be affected by this discontinuance of service.

5. Brief Description of Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers:

The Applicant has provided written customer notice of the planned discontinuance in accordance with the requirements of section 63.71 (a) of the Commission's Rules by notice dated October 9, 2009. Notice was provided via letter sent first class mail to each affected customer. A copy of the customer notice is appended hereto as Exhibit A.

Notice has been sent to the Florida Public Service Commission, Florida Governor's office and the Department of Defense, as required under Section 63.71, concurrent with this filing. A service list is provided in Exhibit B.

Conclusion

Pursuant to Section 214 (a) of the Communication Act of 1934, as amended, and 47 C.F.R. §63.71, Network Telephone Corporation understands that this application will be automatically granted on the 31ⁿ day after the Public Notice is released, with no Commission notification to the Company, unless the Commission has notified the Company that the grant will not be automatically effective.
