I'm Phillip Ellis with Commission staff. Commissioners, Item 6 is a petition from Progress Energy Florida requesting approval of its 2009 standard offer contract. The petition updates the avoided unit and includes an availability typical for the life of the avoided unit of 94 percent. It also removes the right of first refusal for tradable renewable energy credits. Staff believes the proposed standard offer is in compliance with the Commission's rules and recommends approval of Progress' modifications to its renewable energy tariff.

Staff is available to answer any questions you may have. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you.
Commissioners, any questions?

Commissioner Skop, you're recognized for questions. COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Just the same comment as I had before with respect to -- I respect the majority's decision to amend the contract to remove the right of first refusal; but, again, my position would be that that might make sense ultimately. So $I$ just wanted to reiterate my previous comment.
