FPL should, at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the GAF tariff in October 2010, file a report with the Commission providing an updated quantification of storm restoration benefits based on any new storm-restoration data. Based on the analysis, FPL should also petition the Commission at that time to continue, modify, or discontinue the tariff.
