AQUA UTILITIES FLORIDA, INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF SUPPLEMENTAL CUSTOMER-SPECIFIC INFORMATION REQUESTED BY STAFF

Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. ("AUF"), pursuant to Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, respectfully requests confidential classification of supplemental customer-specific information requested by staff (the "Request"). In support of the Request, AUF states:

- 1. In accordance with the Quality of Service Monitoring Plan in Order No. PSC-09-0385-FOF-WS (the "Order"), AUF is required to submit to the Commission (i) a monthly report listing all customer complaints for the first six (6) months after the Order is issued and (ii) sound recordings of customer complaints for the same period. Order at 22. In compliance with those directives, AUF has filed with the Commission the reports and sound recordings of all customer inquiries (including complaints) for the months of May, June, July, August and September 2009, respectively.
- 2. The sound recordings submitted by AUF reflect dialogues between the customer and AUF' customer service representatives which necessarily involves sensitive customer-specific information such as proprietary credit card data, Social Security number, bank account number, customer medical condition, address, and other highly confidential customer-specific information, disclosure of which would harm the privacy interests of individual customers and subject those customers to other harm, including potential identity theft. Consequently, AUF has

formally requested confidential classification of that customer-specific information on June 22, July 20, July 23, August 20, August 31, September 21, October 20, and October 30, 2009 ("Prior Requests").

3. Commission staff recently contacted AUF and advised that it was having difficulty opening the discs containing sound recordings of customer inquires made on September 25 and September 28, 2009. Staff requested that AUF supplement its prior filing for the month of September and provide staff with replacement discs of the sound recordings for September 25 and 28, 2009.

Sound Recordings

4. In response to staff's request, AUF is supplementing its prior filing by submitting new replacement discs of sound recordings of customer calls made on September 25 and 28, 2009. In accordance with Florida Administrative Code Rule 25-22.006(4)(b), two (2) unedited discs containing the requested sound recordings is attached as Confidential Exhibit "A". Pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rule 25-22.006, detailed justification for the confidential classification of the sound recordings has been set forth in AUF's Prior Requests. Because the information in Confidential Exhibit "A" is stored in electronic format, it is not possible to redact the confidential information contained therein. These discs have been placed in a sealed envelope marked "CONFIDENTIAL" and should receive confidential treatment by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing and for the reasons set forth in AUF's Prior Requests, AUF requests that the electronically stored customer-specific information contained in the discs attached in Confidential Exhibit "A" be classified as confidential and exempt from

Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, and Article I, Section 24(a), of the Florida Constitution for the maximum period.
