ORDER APPROVING NAME CHANGE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 26, 2009, an application was filed on behalf of Pluris Wedgefield, LLC (utility) for acknowledgement of the name change of the utility. The utility was granted Certificate Nos. 404-W and 341-S in 1983. Econ Utilities Corporation was the original owner of the utility. The utility has been transferred three times, including once at the parent level, and the utility's territory has been amended once. In 1996, we approved the transfer of Econ Utilities Corporation to Wedgefield Utilities, Inc. and, in a separate docket, the utility's territory was amended. In 2006, we approved the transfer of majority organizational control of the utility's parent. In 2009, Wedgefield was transferred to Pluris Wedgefield, LLC.

The application was filed pursuant to Rule 25-30.039, Florida Administrative Code, which provides for changes in name only, with no change in the ownership or control of the utility or its assets. The reason given for the name change is the limited liability company was converted to a corporation. The utility's name has been changed to Pluris Wedgefield, Inc.

A statement is provided in the application by the former sole member of the LLC and current president of Pluris Wedgefield, Inc., attesting that there will be no change in the utility's ownership, control, or service provided to customers. The application includes documentation from the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, that the new corporation was registered in Florida effective April 21, 2009. The application contains a copy of the proposed notice to be sent to customers informing them of the name change. The proposed notice has been reviewed and approved by our Commission staff. The closing on the transfer mentioned above will not occur until December or January of 2009, at which time the utility will notice the customers of the new name.

A statement was provided in the application by the former sole member of the LLC and current president of Pluris Wedgefield, Inc., attesting that there will be no change in the utility's ownership, control, or service provided to customers. Therefore, the utility's request for name change is approved effective the date of this order. After the date of closing on the transfer of the utility the utility shall send the approved notice to all existing customers with the next regular billing, advising them of the name change. The resultant order shall serve as the utility's water and wastewater certificates and should be retained by the utility.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the request by Pluris Wedgefield, LLC for name change to Pluris Wedgefield, Inc. is approved effective the date of this order. It is further

ORDERED that after the date of closing on the transfer of the utility the utility shall send the approved notice to all existing customers with the next regular billing, advising them of the name change. It is further

ORDERED that the resultant order shall serve as Pluris Wedgefield, Inc.'s amended Certificate Nos. 404-W and 341-S and, as such, it shall be retained by the utility. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall be closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk, and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
