AT&T Inc. on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Corp., ("AT&T") applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended ("the Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214 and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue offering Directory Link service throughout all fifty states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

AT&T plans to discontinue offering this service on or after January 15, 2010, subject to Commission approval of this application.

Directory Link service will be discontinued throughout all fifty states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), (b(2)):

Directory Link service allows a customer to complete a domestic or international long distance call to the telephone number received from AT&T Directory Assistance, provided by AT&T Corp, when dialing XXX-555-1212 without hanging up and originating a separate call.

AT&T has decided not to pursue upgrades to the platforms that would make this service compatible with changing industry requirements. As a result, the functionality that performs call completion service will no longer be available.

The public convenience and necessity is not harmed by AT&T's discontinuance of this service because call completion services will continue to be available for local calls from AT&T's ILEC affiliates when dialing 411 in AT&T's 22-state region. In addition, many wireless carriers provide call completion services to their subscribers when they call directory assistance from their wireless device.

Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(3)):

AT&T does not generally keep records of customers who utilize pay per use services, like Directory Link. However, in preparation for filing this Application, AT&T researched the billing records for this service over the past three months and on November 24, 2009 sent a discontinuance notification via U.S. Mail to customers that utilized this service during that time period. A copy of the customer notification is attached hereto as Attachment A. In addition, AT&T also updated the Directory Link platform with a service discontinuance announcement to inform any additional customers of AT&T's plans to discontinue this service.

¹ Furthermore, AT&T Corp. will continue to provide call completion services to the visually or physically impaired community if the end user calls an operator by dialing "00" and requests for the call to be completed.
