CHAIRMAN CARTER: We're now, Commissioners and staff on Item 17. Staff, kind of get in place for that one.

(Pause.)

CHAIRMAN CARTER: You guys ready?
Staff, you're recognized.

MR. SLEMKEWICZ: John Slemkewicz, staff.

Item Number 17 is Progress Energy Florida, Inc.'s request to establish a regulatory asset or liability in lieu of implementing the proposed \$500 million base rate increase effective January 1, 2010.

Staff is recommending that the Commission approve PEF's request to establish a regulatory asset or liability. In addition, no interest should be accrued on the regulatory asset or liability. And staff is prepared to answer any questions.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Commissioner Skop, you're recognized.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Mr. Chair.

And, again, that's what I was just looking for was a brief explanation on this. This had come up previously, but it was -- I guess the concern of the Commission was to minimize any impact on the ratepayers notwithstanding Progress' legal right to

implement rates or the proposed rates subject to 1 refund. I think this is an alternative to that to 2 the extent that they would create a regulatory 3 asset, be able to recover those amounts, but no 4 interest would accrue on that asset. Is that 5 correct? 6 MR. SLEMKEWICZ: That's correct. 7 COMMISSIONER SKOP: All right. Thank you. 8 CHAIRMAN CARTER: And I'm comfortable with 9 Thank you, Commissioner, because we did talk 10 about that. It seemed like forever ago we were 11 12 going through all the rate cases and things of that nature. I'm comfortable with that explanation. 13 Commissioners, any further questions for 14 staff? Commissioner Argenziano. 15 16 COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Just a comment. 17 CHAIRMAN CARTER: You're recognized. COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you, Mr. 18 19 Chairman. 20 You have to appreciate the responsiveness 21 to minimizing any impact to the ratepayers, so I do 22 appreciate that. 23 CHAIRMAN CARTER: Commissioner Edgar. 24 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Mr. Chairman, I do recognize that for a variety of reasons, the 25

confluence of all kinds of different things that 1 2 procedurally with this docket we are in a pretty unique position, and I think that the approach 3 that's taken in the item before us and with the work of staff and all of the interested parties is a good 5 approach, and I would move the staff recommendation. 6 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Second. 7 CHAIRMAN CARTER: A motion and a second. 8 9 Commissioners, any questions?
