2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(2), (b)(2)):

Subject to the Commission's authorization to discontinue service pursuant to Section 63.71(c) of the Commission's rules, on or after March 31, 2010, Verizon will discontinue Wholesale Video Transport Service. Verizon currently has no customers for this service.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), b(2)):

Verizon offers Wholesale Video Transport Service in California and Florida. Subject to the Commission's authorization, Verizon will discontinue this service in those jurisdictions.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(4), b(2)):

Wholesale Video Transport Service allows customers to transport broadcast and off-air video and audio signals one-way via analog from a cable television operator's headend location to another headend location or from a headend location to a remote receiver site.

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by this proposed service discontinuance. First, there are no customers for this service. Second, Verizon and other providers offer comparable alternative services.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (b)(3)):

Currently, there are no customers for this service. Accordingly, there are no customers to notify about this proposed discontinuance.

As required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules, copies of this Application are being sent via first class U.S. Mail to the governor and public utilities commission for Florida and California, and also to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b)(4)):

Verizon is considered dominant with respect to the service to be discontinued.
