

NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION ORDER CANCELLING INTRASTATE INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS TARIFFS AND REGISTRATIONS ON THE COMMISSION'S OWN MOTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

New Venture L.L.C., Pioneer Telecom, Inc., and Atlantic Ventures Group, Inc. d/b/a/Direct Connek currently hold Intrastate Interexchange Telecommunications (IXC) Registration Nos. TK249, TI534, and TK105, respectively. Pursuant to Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, telecommunications companies must pay a minimum annual Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) for each certificate or registration if the certificate or registration was active during any portion of the calendar year. Pursuant to Rule 25-4.0161(2), Florida Administrative Code, the form and applicable fees are due to the Florida Public Service Commission by January 30 of the subsequent year. Pursuant to Section 350.113(4), Florida Statutes, the Regulatory Assessment Fee return forms, for the period of January 1 through December 31, are mailed to entities at least 45 days prior to the date that payment of the fee is due.
