Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 100310-TL - Petition for expedited review of growth code denials by the Number Pooling Administration for the

West Palm Beach exchange (Riviera Beach) by AT&T Florida.

On May 17, 2010, AT&T Florida filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the West Palm Beach exchange, Riviera Beach (WPBHFLGRDS0) switch. AT&T Florida requested a full NXX to establish a test code for its new remote switch that will be replacing the IAESS switch in Riviera Beach. AT&T Florida is requesting unused NPA NXX in order to properly test the switch. These numbers will be returned in approximately 1 year after it is effective. On May 17, 2010, AT&T Florida's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On May 28, 2010, AT&T filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the AT&T Florida petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (June 16, 2010), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide AT&T Florida the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the West Palm Beach exchange, Riviera Beach (WPBHFLGRDS0) switch.
