FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S REVISED REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF MATERIALS PROVIDED PURSUANT TO AUDIT NO. 09-363-4-1

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain material provided to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") pursuant to Audit Control No. 09-363-4-1 ("the Audit"). In support of its request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. On July 14, 2010, FPL filed its Request for Confidential Classification of Materials Provided Pursuant to Audit No. 09-363-4-1, with attached Exhibits A through D ("July 14, 2010 Request"). FPL adopts and incorporates by reference its July 14, 2010 Request and exhibits.
- 2. FPL has determined that some of the information that was confidential at the time of the July 14, 2010 Request, no longer requires confidential treatment. Accordingly, FPL is filing this Revised Request for Confidential Classification.
- 3. Included herewith and made a part hereof, is Revised Exhibit A, Revised Exhibit B, and Revised Exhibit C.
- 4. Revised Exhibits A and B are not intended to replace Exhibits A and B, which were filed with FPL's July 14, 2010 Request, in their entirety. Revised Exhibits A consists of modified highlighted copies of the specific working papers where FPL has determined that a portion of the information previously designated as confidential no longer requires confidential

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treatment. The information in Revised Exhibit A for which FPL seeks confidential classification has been highlighted. Revised Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed envelope marked "Revised Exhibit A – Confidential." Revised Exhibit B is an edited version of Revised Exhibit A, in which the information FPL asserts remains confidential has been redacted. The revised highlighted and redacted pages in Revised Exhibits A and B are intended to replace the correspondingly numbered working papers FPL filed in Exhibits A and B with its original July 14, 2010 Request. Due to the voluminous nature of the original Exhibits A and B, FPL has included in Revised Exhibits A and B only the specific pages on which the confidentiality designation has changed. The following working papers were revised, and are identified in Revised Exhibits A, B, and C: 19-2 and 19-2/11. These revised pages are subject to, and should be handled consistent with, FPL's July 14, 2010 Request.

- 5. Revised Exhibit C is intended to replace Exhibit C, which was filed with FPL's July 14, 2010 Request. FPL has identified all of the information that warrants continued confidential treatment in Revised Exhibit C ("Confidential Information"). Revised Exhibit C contains a table identifying the specific pages, and the line(s) or column(s) on those pages, which remain confidential. The table also contains references to the specific statutory basis or bases for the claim of confidentiality, and to the affidavits in support of the requested classification.
- 6. Exhibit D, which was filed with FPL's July 14, 2010 Request, includes the affidavits of Antonio Maceo, Damaris Rodriguez, Noah F. Narut, Carmine A. Priore, Solomon L. Stamm, Edward S. Bowman, Frank J. Nesbihal, and Gary A. McBean in support of this Request.
- 7. FPL submits that the Confidential Information continues to be proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. The Confidential Information is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as private, its

confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FPL and its customers. Pursuant to section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

- 8. As the affidavits included in Exhibit D indicate, the information provided by FPL contains information related to internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors. Specifically, the materials contain information related to internal auditing reports issued in 2009. Such information is protected from public disclosure pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(b), Florida Statutes.
- 9. The information provided by FPL also contains information related to security measures, systems, and procedures. Specifically, the materials include information relating to security personnel and equipment at FPL facilities. Such information is protected from public disclosure pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(c), Florida Statutes.
- as pricing or other terms, the public disclosure of which would violate nondisclosure terms of FPL's contracts with certain vendors and impair FPL's ability to contract for goods or services on favorable terms in the future. Much of this information is also competitively sensitive, and could impair the competitive interests of the provider of the information. Specifically, the materials include pricing information related to substation equipment repairs, the procurement of legal services, and other transactions with vendors, the disclosure of which would impair FPL's efforts to obtain commercially favorable pricing and terms for similar good or services in the

future. Such information is protected by Sections 366.093(3)(d) and Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

- 11. The materials also include certain customer specific account information. It is FPL's corporate policy not to disclose customer-specific information. This policy includes, but is not limited to: customer names, addresses, telephone numbers, account numbers, rates, billing determinants (kW and kWh usage), conservation savings in kW, kWh and bills. FPL treats such information as confidential and does not disclose it, except as required by law, to entities or persons other than the customer absent the customer's consent. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.
- 12. Additionally, some documents include competitively sensitive information related to certain employees' compensation. Public disclosure of compensation information would enable competing employers to meet or beat the compensation currently offered, resulting in the loss of talented employees, or conversely, the need to increase the level of compensation already paid in order to retain these employees and attract new talent. The quality of service and the cost of service implications would be detrimental to FPL and its customers. Such information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.
- 13. Nothing has changed since the filing of FPL's July 14, 2010 Request to render the Confidential Information stale or public, such that continued confidential treatment would not be appropriate.
- 14. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Confidential Information remains proprietary and confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for at least an additional eighteen (18) month period and should be returned to FPL as soon as it is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for the above and forgoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavits included herewith and incorporated herein by reference, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its Revised Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
