- 1. For each individual person, in each firm providing consulting services to AUF, please provide a description and associated cost for any and all expenses incurred to date.
- 2. For each firm or consultant providing services for AUF, please provide copies of any and all invoices for services provided to date.
- 3. Please provide an estimate of costs to complete the case through the end of the PAA process, broken down by hour, for each consultant or employee, including a description of estimated work to be performed, and detail of the estimated remaining expense to be incurred.
- 4. For all individual AUF systems, involved in this case, that have purchased water or wastewater treatment, please provide a table indicating the system, the purchased water/wastewater provider, the bulk rates charged to AUF, and the retail rates charged by these providers for their own residential customers.
- 5. In its response to the Lake Osborne Civic Association's letter, dated February 2, 2011, AUE also requested a pro form increase in purchased water for the Lake Osborne system. AUF also indicated that it is now being billed under multi-family rates, instead of general service rates pursuant to the original purchased water contract dated October 9, 1974. The original contract indicates that AUF will be billed at the general service rates. Please respond to the following:
