2. Home Energy Reporting

- Participation will be based on a random selection of targeted residential customers throughout Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Participating customers must have at least 12 months of continuous billing history at the same address.
- 3. Participating customers will receive, via U.S. mail, a usage report containing analysis of usage based on actual billing history, weather, and available home information; comparison to 100 "neighbors" of similar demographics; and targeted recommendations for energy savings. These reports will be provided bi-monthly on average.
- 4. There is no cost for participating customers.
- Customers may opt-out of the program at any time by contacting Gulf Power and requesting that they be removed from the list of customers receiving Home Energy Reports.

3. Energy Education

- Participation is available to any customer within Gulf Power's service area and is targeted to schools, community/civic/government groups, and trade/professional shows.

Participation Standards

- 1. Participation is available to all residential customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. The Participating Contractor will subtract the incentive paid by Gulf Power from the customer's invoice for services provided as specified below:

HVAC Maintenance:

- a. \$75 for repair, minimum refrigerant charge adjustment up to 1 lb., non-ductwork airflow adjustment, and filter clean/replace
- b. \$40 for indoor coil clean
- c. \$25 for outdoor coil clean
- d. \$75 for strip cut-out install
- e. \$25 for strip cut-out reset

HVAC Early Retirement – Retirement of a working system that, after tune-up, performs no better than 8 EER:

- a. \$600 for minimum 14 SEER heat pump or A/C with 90% AFUE gas furnace
- b. \$1,000 for minimum 16 SEER heat pump or A/C with 90% AFUE gas furnace
- c. \$500/ton for minimum 14 EER geothermal closed-loop system
- d. \$300/ton for minimum 14 EER geothermal equipment if installed to an existing closed-loop system

<u>HVAC Upgrade – New installations and replacements of systems not qualifying for</u> <u>Early Retirement incentives:</u>

a. \$100 for minimum 14 SEER heat pump or A/C with 90% AFUE gas furnace



- b. \$300 for minimum 16 SEER heat pump or A/C with 90% AFUE gas furnace
- c. \$500/ton for minimum 14 EER geothermal closed-loop system

 motor designed for retrofit in an existing air handler
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.

Heat Pump Water Heater Program

- 1. Participation is available to all residential customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- An incentive of \$700 will be provided for "Integrated" units (manufactured combination of heat pump and storage tank).
- 3. An incentive of \$350 will be provided for "add on" heat pumps to existing storage tanks.
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 5. Eligible equipment includes both "air source" and "water source" heat pump water heaters with an energy factor (EF) greater than or equal to 2.0.
- 6. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 7. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

Residential Ceiling Insulation Program

- 1. Participation is available to all residential customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. A one-time incentive of \$0.15 per square foot of qualifying insulation products that are installed over conditioned space will be allowed per residence.
- Qualifying insulation products must be new, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. Customers must increase their existing insulation level by at least R-19. Homes with existing insulation levels of R-30 or greater are not eligible for this incentive.

Proof of SHGC and U-factor compliance should include independent third-party documentation such as NFRC labels or manufacturers' technical specifications.

- 6. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 7. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

- 2. The Participating Contractor will subtract the incentive paid by Gulf Power from the customer's invoice for services provided as specified below:
 - a. \$75 for repair, minimum refrigerant charge adjustment up to 1 lb., nonductwork airflow adjustment, and filter clean/replace per system/circuit (multiple evaporator coils connected to a single condensing unit)
 - b. \$40 for indoor coil clean, ≤ 5 ton
 - c. \$25 for outdoor coil clean, ≤ 5 ton
 - d. \$75 for strip cut-out install, ≤ 5 ton
 - e. \$25 for strip cut-out reset, ≤ 5 ton
 - f. \$60 for indoor coil clean, > 5 ton
 - g. \$35 for outdoor coil clean, > 5 ton
 - h. \$50 economizer repair
 - i. \$35 thermostat commissioning
 - j. \$150 thermostat replacement
 - k. \$95 retrofit economizer controls
 - 1. \$75 lock out install, > 5 ton
 - m. \$25 lock out reset, > 5 ton

 - b. Systems with cooling capacity > 65,000 and ≤ 135,000 BTU/h must be minimum12 EER
 - c. Systems with cooling capacity > 135,000 BTU/h must be minimum 11 EER
 - d. Packaged terminal A/C or heat pump (PTAC or PTHP)
 - i. \leq 12,000 BTU/h must be minimum 12 EER
 - ii. >12,000 BTU/h must be minimum 11 EER
- 3. Incentive of \$500 per ton will be paid for closed loop geothermal heat pump units meeting the minimum efficiency of 14 EER at 86° (ARI/ISO-13256-1 application) entering water temperature and a nominal water flow of 3.0 gallons per minute per ton.
- 4. Incentive of \$250 per ton will be paid for hybrid geothermal heat pump units meeting the minimum efficiency of 14 EER at 86° (ARI/IS0-13256-1 application) entering water temperature and a nominal water flow of 3.0 gallons per minute per ton.
- 5. Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.



- 6. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 7. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

Commercial Building Efficiency Program

2. Heat Pump Water Heaters

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentive of \$125 per 1,000 BTU/h of heating capacity up to a maximum of \$7,500 per unit will be paid according to the following:
 - a. Must have a minimum 3.0 Coefficient of Performance (COP)
 - b. Air source unit ratings must be based on 120 degree (or greater) leaving water
 temperature, and 80/67 degree dry/wet bulb (or less)
 - c. Water source unit ratings must be based on ARI Std. 320 for water source heat pumps, ARI 325 for ground water source heat pumps, ARI Std. 330 for ground source closed loop heat pumps or ARI Std. 870 for performance rating of direct geoexchange heat pumps
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. Qualifying equipment must be installed by licensed contractor.
- 5. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation



- d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
- e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 6. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.
- 7. Neither the payment of an incentive, nor any inspection, observation or verification by the Company shall be deemed to be or construed as a representation, assurance, guaranty, or warranty by the Company of the safety, durability, suitability, or reliability of the installation or equipment.

3. Insulation

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentive of \$0.15 per square foot will be paid for installation of qualifying insulation.
- Qualifying insulation products must be new, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. Incentive available only for existing buildings with dedicated HVAC systems.
- 5. Insulation above suspended ceiling with removable ceiling panels does not qualify.
- 6. Must add a minimum insulation value of R-11 based on manufacturer's specification card. Resulting total R-values must achieve a minimum R-19 for metal buildings or a minimum R-30 for attic and other construction types.
- 7. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of product qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the product)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process



- 8. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.
- 9. Neither the payment of an incentive, nor any inspection, observation or verification by the Company shall be deemed to be or construed as a representation, assurance, guaranty, or warranty by the Company of the safety, durability, suitability, or reliability of the installation or equipment.
- 10. The reporting requirements for this program will be in accordance with Rule 25-17.0021(5), F.A.C.



4. Window Film

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentive of \$1.00 per square foot of glass area will be paid for installation of qualifying window film.
- Qualifying product must be new, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. Window film measure can be tinting or film.
- 5. Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) of qualifying tinting or film must be no greater than 0.25.
- 6. North facing glass does not qualify.
- Qualifying product must be installed on exterior windows and adjacent to conditioned space.
- 8. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of product qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the product)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products



- e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10%
 of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications
 for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.
- 10. Neither the payment of an incentive, nor any inspection, observation or verification by the Company shall be deemed to be or construed as a representation, assurance, guaranty, or warranty by the Company of the safety, durability, suitability, or reliability of the installation or product.
- 11. The reporting requirements for this program will be in accordance with Rule 25-17.0021(5), F.A.C.



5. Reflective Roof

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentive of \$0.50 per square foot will be paid for qualifying installations.
- Qualifying roofing products must be new, and must be purchased and installed during the
 effective dates of the program.
- 4. Qualifying roofing product must be installed over air-conditioned building space.
- 5. Built-up or shingle roofs must have a minimum solar reflectance of 73%; light-colored metal roofs must have a minimum solar reflectance of 65%.
- 6. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of product qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the product)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 7. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.



- 8. Neither the payment of an incentive, nor any inspection, observation or verification by the Company shall be deemed to be or construed as a representation, assurance, guaranty, or warranty by the Company of the safety, durability, suitability, or reliability of the installation or product.
- The reporting requirements for this program will be in accordance with Rule 25-17.0021

6. Indoor Lighting

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. All lighting projects associated with potential incentive payments are subject to evaluation and approval by Gulf Power prior to any initial work.
- 3. Incentive of \$0.15 per Watt reduction for fluorescent lighting meeting the following requirements:
 - a. Ballast designed to operate one specific lamp type and wattage
 - b. Screw-in CFL not eligible
- 4. Incentive of \$0.30 per Watt reduction for LED lighting meeting the following requirements:
 - a. Minimum of 10 lamps replaced
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- Retrofit upgrades must be permanent installations. Lamp replacements only do not qualify.
- Delamping installations require reflector addition and removal of spare ballast and lamp holders.
- 8. New installations must meet a minimum 10% reduction from one of the following reference codes:



- a. Ref: Florida Energy Code 2007 Chapter 13 Energy Efficiency
 - TABLE 13-415.B.1 Lighting Power Densities using the Space-By-Space
 Method

(or)

- TABLE 13-415.C.1 Lighting Power Densities using the Building Area
 Method
- b. Ref: ASHRAE STD. 90.1-2007
 - i. TABLE 9.5.1 Lighting Power Densities using the Building Area Method
 (or)
 - ii. TABLE 9.6.1 Lighting Power Densities using the Space-By-Space Method
- A minimum of 1 kW in lighting reduction must be achieved; based on net energy (wattage) [existing kW - new kW].
- 10. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of product qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the product)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process



- 11. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

7. Lighting Occupancy Sensors

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentive of \$20 per sensor will be paid for qualifying installations.
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. Occupancy sensor installations must be permanent.
- 5. Must be installed in areas where indoor lights would be operating during summer peak times (weekday afternoons between 3 and 6 p.m.).
- 6. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 7. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

Program Standards

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentive of \$75 per occupancy sensor will be paid for qualifying equipment.
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. HVAC occupancy sensor must be installed in lodging facilities only.
- 5. Occupancy sensors installations must be permanent.
- 6. Sensors must be for individual room control and not controlled from a central location.
- 7. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
 - e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 8. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

High Efficiency Motor Program

Program Standards

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Incentives for installation of qualifying motors will be provided as follows:
 - a. \$25 per horsepower for motors between 1 and 5 HP
 - b. \$8 per horsepower for motors > 5 up to 50 HP
 - c. \$3 per horsepower for motors > 50 up to 400 HP
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- 4. Minimum standards for qualifying motors:
 - a. Single or three-phase
 - b. Induction type motor
 - c. Must meet National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) PremiumTM
 nominal efficiency levels (NEMA Standards Publication MG 1-2006, Tables 12 12 and 12-13)
 - d. Open Drip Proof (ODP) or Totally Enclosed Fan-Cooled (TEFC)
 - e. 1200, 1800, or 3600 RPM only
- 5. Qualifying motors must operate a minimum of 2,000 hours annually.
- 6. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application



- b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
- c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
- d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products
- e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 7. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.

Participation Standards

 Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.

2. Incentives for qualifying food service equipment will be paid as follows:

a.	Convection oven	\$350/unit
b.	Fryer	\$200/unit
c.	Griddle	\$300/unit
d.	Steamer	\$750/unit
e.	Holding cabinet	\$300/unit

f. Ice machine

 Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.

\$100/unit

- 4. Food service equipment must be electric and ENERGY STAR® qualified or equivalent.
- 5. Prior to payment of incentive, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Complete incentive application
 - b. Documentation of proof of equipment qualifications (including manufacturer and the appropriate efficiency specifications of the equipment)
 - c. Sales receipt documentation including date of installation
 - d. Application must be made within 60 days of the installation of qualifying products



- e. Installation must pass Gulf Power's verification process
- 6. Gulf, or its designee, will randomly perform full field verification on a minimum of 10% of contractor installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.
- 7. Neither the payment of an incentive, nor any inspection, observation or verification by the Company shall be deemed to be or construed as a representation, assurance, guaranty, or warranty by the Company of the safety, durability, suitability, or reliability of the installation or equipment.

Commercial/Industrial Custom Incentive Program

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- An approved Commercial/Industrial Audit must be performed as a prerequisite for evaluation of any incentive.
- 3. Incentives will be provided in accordance with the following:
 - a. Successful installation, and verification of the energy and demand savings
 - Evaluation of project, including incentives, must pass all cost-effectiveness tests as performed in accordance with Florida Public Service Commission Cost-Effectiveness Manual
 - Total contribution will not bring participant's project payback to less than two years
- Qualifying equipment must be new, operational, and must be purchased and installed during the effective dates of the program.
- The customer will be responsible for all design and construction costs associated with the individual project(s).
- 6. Gulf, or its designee, will perform full field verification on 100% of installations to ensure compliance with program standards. All applications for program incentives will be verified prior to payment.
- Neither the payment of an incentive, nor any inspection, observation or verification by the Company shall be deemed to be or construed as a representation, assurance, guaranty,



or warranty by the Company of the safety, durability, suitability, or reliability of the installation or equipment.

8. The reporting requirements for this program will be in accordance with Rule 25-17.0021 (5), F.A.C.



Real Time Pricing Program

- Participation is available to all commercial and industrial customers in Gulf Power's service area.
- 2. Participation is in accordance with the current approved Rate Schedule RTP.
- The reporting requirements for this program will be in accordance with Rule 25-17.0021
 (5), F.A.C.



Conservation Demonstration and Development (CDD)

1. Electric Vehicle Charging

- 1. Participation is available to any residential customer in Gulf Power's service territory who is eligible for and agrees to remain on the Residential Service Variable Pricing (RSVP) rate as part of the Energy Select® Program for one year. Customer must agree to either utilize an Energy Select® Load Control Relay to control the vehicle charging circuit (240v or less) or show proof of an in-vehicle controller capable of charging the vehicle only during RSVP off-peak hours.
- Vehicles eligible for this pilot must be purchased by an eligible customer during the effective dates of the pilot.
- 3. Application must be made within 60 of the purchase of qualifying vehicle.
- 4. Eligible vehicles include highway capable all-Electric, Plug-in Hybrid Electric (PHEV), and Extended Range Electric (EREV) vehicles. Examples of eligible vehicles include the following: Ford's plug-in hybrid Escape, Ford's all-electric Focus, Chevrolet's extended range electric Volt, Nissan's all-electric Leaf, Toyota's plug-in hybrid Prius, and Volkswagen's all-electric Golf. Low-Speed¹ electric vehicles designed for on-road use, also known as Neighborhood Electric Vehicles or NEVs, purchased by an eligible customer during the pilot are eligible for a smaller rebate.
- Gulf Power will perform a field verification of a randomly selected minimum of 10% of pilot participants to ensure compliance with program standards.
- 6. Participating customers will be eligible for a one-time incentive during the three-year pilot period for one of the following:

¹ Low-Speed Vehicles are defined in F.S. 320.01(42).



- a. \$1,000 for highway-capable vehicle
- b. \$500 for low-speed vehicle
- 7. This pilot will be limited to 100 participants per calendar year.

Monitoring and Evaluation

- 1. Gulf Power will track the following information:
 - a. Number and amount of rebates provided to customers
 - b. Date applications are received and incentives are paid
 - c. Number of disqualified applicants
 - d. Number and type of vehicles in the pilot program
 - e. Estimated demand and energy impact
 - Number of distributors or third party vendors actively promoting the pilot program
- Six (6) months after the end of the pilot, Gulf Power will submit a report documenting
 the information above as well as conclusions and recommendations for future action.
 The report will include a cost-effectiveness analysis and customer satisfaction survey
 results.



Conservation Demonstration and Development (CDD)

2. Miscellaneous Projects

- Technologies evaluated under this program may be applicable to residential, commercial, or industrial applications.
- Technologies evaluated cover a wide variety of activities and are subject to specific screening criteria prior to study implementation. These criteria include potential for energy and demand savings, technology maturity, and broad customer acceptability.
- Any technology evaluated will be subject to comprehensive monitoring and evaluation.
 Prior to implementation, a project justification will be completed including project concept or description, research and design considerations, potential market opportunity, and anticipated costs.
