Mr. Simpson,

After speaking with you last Monday, April 11th, Nathan Hess and I were under the impression that Brendenwood Water System would be given another year to have their rate case looked at while they worked to have their hydropneumatic tank issues addressed. However, I was contacted by Tom Braceland yesterday and told that they had spoken with Karen Hudson at PSC, and she informed them that they would not be granted the one year increase without written approval from DEP. If you could please forward this E-mail to her letting her know that DEP is currently writing a consent order for Brendenwood, under which they will be required to have their tank either repaired or replaced entirely within one year, it would be greatly appreciated. In the meantime please grant them this extension before their case goes before the commission and their case is closed. If there is anything else you need from the DEP in order to have the year extension granted please let me know.
