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#### PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. I apologize for that. We had some slight technical difficulties, but I think they've been all solved.

Let the record show this is the hearing, Docket Number 090539-GU, so we will call this hearing to order. And, Staff, if you'd read the notice, please.

MS. WILLIAMS: By notice issued May 13th, 2011, the time and place was set for this hearing in Docket 090539-GU, In Re: Petition for Approval of Special Gas Transportation Service Agreement with Florida City Gas by Miami-Dade County through Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department. The purpose of this hearing is set forth in that notice.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Very good.

Appearances. Who do we have?

MR. GILLMAN: Henry Gillman on behalf of Miami-Dade County, with the Miami-Dade County Attorney's Office.

MR. HOPE: David Stephen Hope, Assistant County Attorney, on behalf of Miami-Dade County.

MR. SELF: Good afternoon, Commissioners. Floyd Self of the law firm Messer, Caparello & Self. Also appearing with me on my far left is Robert J. Telfer. And also with me today from AGL Resources is

our inside counsel, Ms. Shannon Pierce, who is on my 1 left. 2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commission Staff. 3 MS. WILLIAMS: Anna Williams and Martha Carter Brown on behalf of Commission Staff. 5 6 MS. CIBULA: Samantha Cibula, Commission 7 advisor. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: I hear everybody clicking. 8 9 Everybody is just dying to be first; right? 10 Preliminary matters. MR. SELF: Yes, Mr. Chairman, if I may. I 11 12 have a preliminary matter for the Commission. 13 The parties have reached an agreement by which 14 they have settled the case. There is still the 15 paperwork to be done, but we have reached an agreement 16 on the terms, and we would jointly request that the 17 Commission recess, suspend, postpone, whatever the appropriate term is, the hearings for this week and 18 19 allow the parties to go and get that settlement reduced 20 to writing and then filed and submitted to the 21 Commission and brought to you at a later date for your 22 approval. 23 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: So say you all? 24 MR. HOPE: Yes, Mr. Chairman. And let me just 25 add a couple of other things. We have in theory -- both

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parties need to get certain approvals: Florida City Gas at a corporate level, Miami-Dade County through a legislative level.

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What we've spoken about is we have now reached agreement over the crucial term here of the rates that would be charged retroactively and prospectively. We want to now reduce that, memorialize that in writing with any other terms and conditions that come in from any sort of amendment; and then go back and bring Staff up to speed in terms of where we are so they are comfortable with the rates and the process that we see; then bring that finally back to you for your blessing.

## CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Staff?

MS. WILLIAMS: Staff agrees, if that's the parties' wish and they jointly want to request that this hearing be stopped and go back and put that in writing. I think we'd be on board with that.

### CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commission board?

Well, all I can say is I am glad that you guys have worked this out. I think it always works best for everybody when you guys come to the table and, and are able to come to an agreement. I know, speaking for everybody up here, we're glad when that happens.

Staff, thank you for the work you have done to get us to this point, and thank you guys for giving of

your time and hashing this stuff all out. And not to prolong all this, we're going to cancel this meeting. And do we have to do anything for a time certain?

MS. WILLIAMS: No. I think we will just wait until we get a filing from the parties, and then at that time we'll reschedule and plan when we can bring this for you -- in front of you all for your review.

MR. GILLMAN: Mr. Chair, would it be in order to have a motion to abate this proceeding?

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: I think just canceling it will be sufficient.

MR. GILLMAN: Okay. As long as we know that the, the proceeding is abated at the time. Thank you.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Cancel, kill, get rid of, drag off.

(Laughter.)

MR. SELF: And, Mr. Chairman, if I may, you know, we would like to say that, as you all well know, getting to a settlement is never an easy process, but, but certainly the participation and diligence of the Commission Staff in holding the, the two parties through a rather onerous discovery process -- it was a team effort on the part of both of the parties, and we appreciate the Staff's involvement in this. And we certainly appreciate, on behalf of Florida City Gas,

Miami-Dade County's involvement in working with us to help get us to a mutually agreeable place. CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Well, it sounds good. So we are officially going to adjourn the meeting. Thank you very much. (Proceeding adjourned at 1:42 p.m.)
