RAJIV KUNDALKAR'S REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT ON MOTION TO STAY ORDER NO. PSC-11-0246-PCO-EI

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.0022, Florida Administrative Code, Mr. Rajiv S. Kundalkar ("Movant") hereby requests oral argument on his Motion To Stay Order No. PSC-11-0246-PCO-EI. Oral argument will aid in the Commission's understanding and evaluation of the issues to be decided as follows:

- 1. As explained in Movant's April 12, 2011, Motion to Quash, this Commission's compelling a private citizen (a non-party not employed by a regulated utility) to appear for a deposition in a Commission proceeding has never before been done in the long history of this institution. The Order denied Movant's Motion to Quash. Movant will file for judicial review of the Order. The Motion to Quash presented the Commission with a case of first impression with important policy ramifications; the Motion for Stay of the Order now also presents this Commission with significant and unique questions.
- 2. Oral argument would allow counsel to further explain and discuss the legal standard applicable under the Commission's Stay Rule and the ramifications of the Commission's decision whether to (a) stay the Order, so as to preserve the Movant's right to seek judicial review, or (b) not stay the Order and thereby deprive Movant of his rights when the
