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## PROCEEDINGS

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CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: We are going down to Item Number 10.

Commissioners, Avy Smith on MS. SMITH: behalf of Commission staff. Item 10 is Staff's recommendation for a staff-assisted rate case for Tymber Creek Utilities. Staff is recommending the utility's land rent be treated using the same methodology previously approved by this Commission. The utility disagrees and has requested that the land be recognized at market sales value or market rate.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: In addition, staff would like to make an oral modification regarding the long-term use of land for the utility's percolation ponds discussed on Pages 16 through 20 of the recommendation. Specifically, staff would like to add the following language in the recommendation, "Within 120 days of the consummating order, the utility should provide documentation, such as a 99-year lease or warranty deed, demonstrating that it has complied with Section 367.1213, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.33, Provision 10, Florida Administrative Code.

Staff is prepared to answer any questions

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you have at this time.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you very much.

Tymber Creek, do you have anything? No?

All right. To the Board. Commissioner

Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you, Mr. Chair.

I just want to thank staff for the oral modification. I know there's -- at least I have had a lot of discussion with staff concerning the transfer of the land, and when it occurred, or should have occurred, and so I just want to thank staff for that oral modification. I think it clears the issues up significantly.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioner Edgar.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you, Mr.

Chairman.

I do just want to verify for the record that there is nobody here from the utility who would like to speak to this issue today? That's my understanding; I just wanted to verify.

MR. FLETCHER: That is correct.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: And I, as well, think that the additional modification that the staff has made to answer some questions and give greater

assurance to the customers on a go-forward basis is 1 a good and a positive change, so I thank them for 2 their work on that. 3 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any other discussion? Staff, thank you very much for your quick work. 5 MS. SMITH: Oh, I would just like to add 6 something real quick. I believe when I quoted the rule, I'm not sure if I spoke incorrectly, but it's 8 Rule 25-30.433, Provision 10. 9 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Sounds good. 10 MS. SMITH: I just wanted to clarify that. 11 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: And 120 days? 12 MS. SMITH: Yes. 13 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Okay. 14 Commissioner Edgar. 15 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: If there's no further 16 discussion, Mr. Chairman, then I would move the 17 staff recommendation inclusive of the oral 18 modification that was just made. 19 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It has been moved and 20 seconded, staff recommendation including the oral 21 modification. Any further discussion? 22 All in favor say aye. 23 (Affirmative vote.) 24 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed? 25
