On June 27, 2008, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") filed its Request for Confidential Classification of Information Provided Pursuant to Audit No. 08-003-4-3 (the "June 2008 Request"). The Commission did not issue an order ruling on the June 2008 Request, and on May 6, 2010, FPL filed a Renewed Request for Confidential Classification of Materials Provided Pursuant to Audit No. 08-003-4-3 (the "May 2010 Renewed Request"). At the time of the May 2010 Renewed Request, FPL had determined that some of the materials for which FPL had sought confidential classification in the June 2008 Request no longer needed confidential classification; the May 2010 Renewed Request sought confidential classification for only those materials that continued to require confidentiality.

On July 18, 2011, FPL was contacted by the Commission Staff concerning the May 2010 Renewed Request. Staff stated that it had identified a small number of workpapers that were listed on Exhibit C to the May 2010 Renewed Request but which Staff could not locate in Exhibits A and B to the May 2010 Renewed Request. Staff asked FPL to provide within 21 days highlighted and redacted copies of the workpapers that Staff had identified as missing, for which FPL continues to seek confidential classification.

FPL has reviewed Staff's list of missing workpapers and has determined the following:

Thus, there remain only three workpapers among those identified by Staff for which FPL continues to seek confidential classification: WP 41-2/5-3, Page 12; WP 45-3/1-1, Page 3; and WP 45-3/2-1, Page 3. Each of those workpapers was identified as confidential on Exhibit C to both the June 2008 Request and the May 2010 Renewed Request, so FPL has already requested confidential classification with respect to them and that request remains pending. I am enclosing for filing in the above docket highlighted and redacted copies of those three workpapers, which supplement Exhibits A and B, respectively, of the May 2010 Renewed Request. The highlighted copy of the workpapers is enclosed in a separate envelope that is marked "Confidential." I am also enclosing for filing the original and seven (7) copies of a revised Exhibit C to the May 2010 Renewed Request, reflecting that FPL is no longer seeking confidential classification for the following workpapers, as noted above: WP 44-1/2, Page 1; WP 44-1/2-1, Page 2; WP 44-2/2, Page 1; and WP 45-3/3-1, Page 3.
