RE: Closure of Docket No. 100468-TI, Acknowledgement of registration as intrastate interexchange telecommunications company by Netline Communications Corp. d/b/a clubip.com

On December 10, 2010, Netline Communications Corp. d/b/a clubip.com (Netline) filed an interexchange telecommunications company (IXC) registration form and tariff, seeking acknowledgement from the Commission to operate as a registered IXC in Florida. Upon receipt of the registration form and tariff, Docket No. 100468-TI was established. After the docket was established, staff determined that Netline had penalties imposed against it in two prior compliance dockets (Docket Nos. 060065-TX and 070522-TI). Netline was informed that it needed to resolve the issues associated with the two prior dockets before a new IXC registration could be acknowledged. Therefore, on March 14, 2011, Netline submitted a proposed settlement offer, wherein the company offered to submit a payment in the amount of \$3,500, to resolve the outstanding penalties in Docket Nos. 060065-TX and 070522-TI.

By Order No. PSC-11-0233-PAA-TI, issued May 25, 2011, the Commission accepted the company's proposed settlement offer. The Commission further ordered that this docket should be closed administratively upon the receipt of the settlement payment or no earlier than 14 calendar days after the issuance of the Consummating Order. The Order became final and effective on June 20, 2011, upon issuance of Consummating Order No. PSC-11-0267-CO-TI.

Fourteen calendar days after the issuance of the Consummating Order has elapsed. However, the company's settlement payment has not been received. Therefore, since Netline has failed to comply with the terms of the Commission's orders, this docket shall be closed administratively.

Staff notes that due to passage of the Telecom Reform Act, effective July 1, 2011, the Commission no longer has jurisdiction over IXCs. However, if Netline decides to seek a Certificate of Authority to provide competitive local exchange services the company will be required at that time to pay the penalties previously imposed in Docket No. 060065-TX before a new certificate will be granted.
