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## CUSTOMER NOTICE <br> ISSUED <br> DOCKET NO. 100128 -WU

On September 1, 2010, Lighthouse Utilities Company, Inc. (the "Utility") filed its application with the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") for increased water service rates, in which it requested a permanent revenue increase for customer of its water system in Gulf County of $\$ 172,300$.

By Proposed Agency Action ("PAA") Order No. PSC-11-0368-PAA-WU, issued September 1, 2011, the Commission approved an increase of $\$ 60,287$ in revenue or approximately a $12.82 \%$ increase. The Commission determined this revenue increase will allow LUCI an opportunity to recover its operating expenses and earn a return of $8.97 \%$ on its investments necessary to provide reliable water service. To realize the revenues required by the Company, the Commission has authorized an increase in the rates and charges of the Company. The revised rates and charges are set forth in the schedule below but include increases for water, miscellaneous service charges, approval of a late fee and for nonsufficient fund charges when a check is not honored by the customer's bank. Although not requested by LUCI, the Commission also modified the method for applying service availability charges.

The PAA Order was not protested and became final by Order No. PSC-11- $\qquad$ -FOF-Wu, issued [September 22, 2011].

The increased rates and charges shown in the following schedule are effective for service on and after $\qquad$ .

## NON-SUFFICIENT FUND ("NSF") CHECK CHARGES

The Utility is requesting approval of NSF Check charges that may be levied pursuant to Section 68.065 and Section $832.08(5)$, Florida Statutes, when a customer pays by check and that check is dishonored by the customer's banking institution. The Company will charge the amount set by Section 68.065 and Section 832.08 (5), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. As currently set forth in Section 832.08(5), the following fees may be assessed.

1. $\$ 25$, if the face value does not exceed $\$ 50.00$,
2. $\$ 30$, if the face value exceeds $\$ 50$ but does not exceed $\$ 300$,
3. $\$ 40$, if the face value exceeds $\$ 300$, or five present $(5 \%)$ of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.

## SERVICE AVAILABILITY CHARGES

Although not proposed by the Company, the Commission revised the Service Availability charges to have separate charges for cost of plant and cost of lines rather than a single charge. The separate charges are:

## MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES

The company may charge the following miscellaneous service charges in accordance with the terms stated herein. If both water and wastewater services are provided, only a single charge is appropriate unless circumstances beyond the control of the Company require multiple actions.

INITIAL CONNECTION- This charge may be levied for service initiation at a location where service did not exist previously.

NORMAL RECONNECTION- This charge may be levied for transfer of services to a new Customer account at a previously served location or reconnection of service subsequent to a Customer requested disconnection.

VIOLATION RECONNECTION- This charge may be levied prior to reconnection of an existing Customer after disconnection of service for cause according to Rule 25-30.320(2), Florida Administrative Code, including a delinquency in bill payment.

PREMISES VISIT CHARGE- This charge may be levied when a service representative visits a premises for the purpose of discontinuing service for nonpayment of a due and collectible bill and does not discontinue service because the Customer pays the service representative or otherwise makes satisfactory arrangements to pay the bill.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE- This charge would be levied when the instrument used to pay the utility bill is not honored by the Customer's financial institution when presented for payment by the Utility.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE- This charge would be levied when a customer's billing account is not paid within 20 days, and is therefore delinquent.

## SERVICE AVAILABILITY POLICY

Service availability charges and policy were grandfathered based upon charges and policy in effect upon the jurisdictional date. Order No. 18897, Docket No. 870627-WU Revised.

The utility has in place water treatment plants and water mains extended through its existing territory. In addition to a $\$ 157$ per ERC plant capacity charge and a $\$ 843$ per ERC main installation charge, the utility bills the customer actual cost for tapping the main, running the service and placing the meter.
