MS. GOLDEN: Commissioners, Item 13 is an application for water and wastewater certificates by Bimini Bay Utilities Corporation. Staff is recommending that the certificate should be denied.

MS. BENNETT: In my opinion it would be cleaner to just go ahead and approve staff's recommendation. If they choose to protest, they can,

or they can apply for the certificate once they've 1 addressed all of the issues that they have. 2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Sounds fair. 3 Commissioner Edgar. COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you, Mr. 5 Chairman. I was basically going to say what Ms. Bennett 7 just said, which is that from my perspective to move 8 forward on the staff recommendation today, recognizing 9 that the utility and, of course, their counsel and 10 other representatives would have the option to reapply 11 in the future when they are ready to do so without 12 prejudice. 13 So, Mr. Chairman, I would move the staff 14 recommendation on all issues for Item 13. 15 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It has been moved and 16 seconded, staff recommendation on Item 13. Any 17 further discussion? 18 Seeing none. All in favor say aye. 19 (Unanimous affirmative vote.) 20 21 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed? 22 By your action, you've approved staff recommendation on Item Number 13. 23 Thank you very much. 24 MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, and 25
