SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files this request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain supplemental information submitted by Gulf Power on its FPSC Form 423 Fuel Report for the month of July, 2011. As grounds for this request, the Company states:

- On September 28, 2011, Gulf Power filed a Request for Confidential
 Classification pertaining to certain information contained in the Company's FPSC Form 423
 Fuel Report for the month of July 2011. (Document No. 07021-11)
- 2. On October 25, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. PSC-11-0492-CFO-EI granting Gulf Power's request.
- 3. Subsequent to the issuance of Order No. PSC-11-0492-CFO-EI, Gulf discovered that the Rail Rate used to calculate pricing data for coal deliveries to Plant Scholz in July was incorrect. As a result, Gulf Power is submitting updated information relating fuel purchases for Plant Scholz on Form Nos. 423-2, 423-2(a) and 423-2(b).
- 4. A portion of the information contained on the foregoing pages constitutes proprietary confidential business information concerning bids and other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of Gulf Power to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. The information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(3)(d) and(e), Florida Statutes. Specifically, the confidential information consists of pricing for coal and related transportation services purchased by Gulf Power. Gulf Power and the counterparties involved in these transactions consider the foregoing information to be

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confidential and competitively sensitive. Disclosure of this information could negatively impact Gulf's ability to negotiate pricing favorable to its customers in the future. In addition, potential counterparties may refuse to enter into future contracts with Gulf, or may charge higher prices, if the confidential information is publicly disclosed.

- 5. To this attorney's knowledge, the pricing information regarding shipments in this month's report has not been otherwise publicly disclosed. This information is intended to be, and is treated as, confidential by Gulf Power.
- 6. Submitted as Exhibit "A" are copies of the subject documents, on which are highlighted the information for which confidential classification is requested. Exhibit "A" should be treated as confidential pending a ruling on this request. Attached as Exhibit "B" are two (2) edited copies of the subject documents, which may be made available for public review and inspection. Attached as Exhibit "C" to this request is a line-by-line/field-by-field justification for the request for confidential classification.

WHEREFORE, Gulf Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order protecting the information highlighted on Exhibit "A" from public disclosure as proprietary confidential business information.
