NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Rule 25-22.080(3), Florida Administrative Code, that the Florida Public Service Commission has received a petition from Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) for a determination of need for the construction of a combined cycle natural gas unit with about 1,277 MW of generation. FPL proposes to construct this unit at the existing Port Everglades plant site with commercial operation proposed to begin in June 2016. This matter has been assigned Commission Docket No. 110309-EI.


