# AT&T FLORIDA'S RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO FLATEL'S SECOND MOTION TO REINSTATE

BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC<sup>1</sup> d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida") respectfully submits its Response in Opposition to the second Motion to Reinstate filed by FLATEL, Inc. ("FLATEL") on January 11, 2012. The arguments raised by FLATEL are the same as the arguments raised in its prior filings, and AT&T Florida will not repeat its responses here. Instead, AT&T Florida submits this response for the limited purpose of responding to the email chain that FLATEL attached as Exhibit A to its second motion. The discussion in that email chain is irrelevant to the issues in this docket and AT&T Florida respectfully requests that the Commission not give it any consideration.

#### **ARGUMENT**

This docket concerns FLATEL's breach of its Commission-approved Interconnection

Agreement by failing to pay its bills for resale service in full as required by the plain and
unambiguous terms of that Interconnection Agreement. In a transparent attempt to manipulate
the Commission into ruling in its favor, FLATEL submitted a portion of an email chain from last
week involving a different contract between the parties – the Commercial Agreement between

AT&T Florida and FLATEL for the provision of Local Wholesale Complete service (mistakenly
referred to by FLATEL as UNE-P service). FLATEL wrongly argues that the January 2012

email chain establishes that AT&T Florida refused to negotiate the terms and conditions of the Interconnection Agreement more than six years ago. FLATEL is wrong by all counts.

A complete copy of the email chain is attached here as <u>Exhibit 1</u>. FLATEL focuses on the response to its inquiry as to whether terms "such as rates, PROMO, etc" are negotiable, in which a representative of AT&T Florida responded "Unfortunately no." (Ex. 1 at 1.) FLATEL's arguments that there is something wrong with this response and that it is relevant here are without merit.

First, the complete email chain confirms that the question and response relate to the Commercial Agreement. The subject of the email chain is "UNEP Contract," and begins with a question from a FLATEL representative asking about those services and the renewal status of the "UNE contract." (Ex. 1 at 5.) AT&T Florida provides Local Wholesale Complete services<sup>2</sup> to its CLEC customers pursuant to rates, terms and conditions contained within Commercial Agreements, not the Interconnection Agreement that is at issue in this proceeding. In context, it is clear that the AT&T Florida response to FLATEL's question about whether terms "such as rates, PROMO, etc" are negotiable referred to AT&T Florida's rates for the Local Wholesale Complete service.

Second, this email discussion from January 2012 is irrelevant to the negotiations concerning its Interconnection Agreement, which was entered in July 2005 and extended in 2009. See generally Docket Nos. 050492-TP, 090028-TP. What AT&T Florida said in January 2012 in the context of a different contract is completely irrelevant. If FLATEL felt that AT&T Florida did not negotiate in good faith in connection with the Interconnection Agreement, it had the right under federal law to either mediate the provision with the assistance of the Commission

Local Wholesale Complete, previously known in Florida as Wholesale Local Platform, is a voluntary service offering that AT&T Florida developed when it was relieved of its obligations to provide UNE-P.

or present the disagreement to the Commission and have the Commission determine through an arbitration what language the parties would include in the Interconnection Agreement. See generally 47 U.S.C. § 252(a), (b). FLATEL's decision not to invoke its legal rights then does not allow it to ask the Commission to re-write its Interconnection Agreement now.

AT&T Florida, therefore, respectfully requests that the Commission deny FLATEL's Motions to Reinstate and grant AT&T Florida's Motion to Dismiss in its entirety.
