# AT&T FLORIDA'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On February 22, 2012, AT&T Florida served its *Second Supplemental* Response to Express Phone Service, Inc.'s ("Express Phone") First Request for Production of Documents No. 6, dated January 24, 2012.
- 2. AT&T Florida's Second Supplemental response to Express Phone's First Request for Production of Documents No. 6 consisted of three compact discs that contain billing records of Express Phone and thus contain customer- specific information that is considered confidential and proprietary by AT&T Florida and Express Phone. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.
- 3. The information discussed in the Request for Specified Confidential Classification is confidential to Express Phone and related to its competitive interests.

  Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

4. Attachment A to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated as confidential.

5. Because the information that AT&T Florida seeks to protect as confidential and proprietary pursuant to this Request for Confidential Classification are the entire contents of the three CDs which contain voluminous electronic billing records (all of which are confidential business information of Express Phone), AT&T Florida is unable to produce redacted or highlighted copies of the CDs. AT&T Florida will produce additional copies of the CDs upon the request of the Commission.

7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Office of the Commission Clerk and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, AT&T Florida respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
