On January 13, 2012, the Commission's Office of Auditing and Performance Analysis commenced an audit of Gulf's Power Company's Fuel Cost Recovery Clause, Audit Control Number 12-013-1-2. On May 31, 2012, an audit exit conference was held. During the conference, Commission auditors notified Gulf that the Commission intends to retain 273 pages of workpapers and other documents which Gulf had previously identified as containing potentially confidential information using Form PSC/RCA 6-R (2/95). See, Document No. 03481-12. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)2, F.A.C., absent good cause, Gulf Power must file a request for confidential classification within 21 days after the audit exit conference in order to maintain continued confidential handling of these materials. The current deadline for filing a request for confidential classification is therefore June 21, 2012. The personnel necessary to perform a detailed confidentiality review of the 273 pages at issue have been unavailable due to other work-related activities. Given the unavailability of necessary personnel and the substantial volume of documents at issue, Gulf Power respectfully requests an extension of 16 days, up to and including July 6, 2012 to prepare and file its request for confidential classification.
