The following is Pluris Wedgefield, Inc.'s ("Utility") response to Staff's First Data Request dated August 31, 2012.

1. The following items relate to all proforma plant additions reflected on MFR Schedule A-3 and A-3(a). For each addition, provide the following:

(a) Statement why each addition is necessary;

<u>RESPONSE</u>: VFD for #3 high service – The VFD was added to replace the hydro-tank due to deterioration of the tank. The VFD negates the need for the hydro-tank by adjusting to the pressure demand as needed.

SCADA system for wells, high service pumps, and MIEX plant - The original system was failing and the owner of the original system would not stand behind its product.

Weir replacement on east wastewater treatment plant – The old weirs were falling apart and producing an uneven flow across them.

(b) A copy of all invoices and other support documentation if the plant addition has been completed or in process;

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoices labeled "Plant Invoices for Additions".

(c) A copy of the signed contract or any bids, if the plant addition has

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not been completed;

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The plant addition has been completed.

(d) A status of the engineering and permitting effort, if the plant addition has not been through the bidding process;

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached permit labeled "VFD Permit". Permits were not required for the SCADA system or Weir replacement.

(e) The projected in-service date for each outstanding plant addition and,

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The additions have all been placed in service (VFD – May 15, 2012; SCADA system for wells and high service pumps – May 15, 2012; SCADA system for MIEX plant – June 28, 2012; Wier replacement for wastewater plant – June 13, 2012).

(f) All documentation (i.e. invoices) for the original cost of any corresponding retirements.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The Utility does not have original cost documentation for any corresponding retirements since the facilities were placed in service prior to the Utility's purchase of the systems.

2. The following items relate to Pluris' requested rate case expense.

(a) For each individual person, in each firm providing consulting services to the applicant pertaining to this docket, provide the billing rate, and an itemized description of work performed. Please provide detail of hours worked with each activity. Also provide a description and associated cost for all expenses incurred to date.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoices labeled "Rate Case Invoices" for details of billing rates and work performed for each person.

(b) For each firm or consultant providing services for the applicant in this docket, please provide copies of all invoices for services provided to date.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoices labeled "Rate Case Invoices".

(c) If rate consultant invoices are not broken down by hour, provide reports that detail by hour, a description of actual duties performed, and amount incurred to date.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Attached invoices are broken down by hour.

(d) Please provide an estimate of costs to complete the case by hour for each consultant or employee, including a description of estimated work to be performed, and detail of the estimated remaining expense to be incurred through the PAA process.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoices labeled "Rate Case Invoices".

(e) Please provide an itemized list of all other costs estimated to be incurred through the PAA process.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoices labeled "Rate Case Invoices" for estimated costs to be incurred.

3. The following items relate to MFR Schedule B-5 and B-6

(a) Contractual Services- Acct. increased substantially in May, September October and November 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in the Contractual Services – Acct.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: May 2011 included accounting work performed related to the 2010 Annual Report. September 2011 included accounting work performed related to preparation of 2010 taxes. October and November 2011 included accounting work performed on the 2010 Audit. See attachment labeled "Contractual Services – Acct Invoices".

(b) Contractual Services- Legal increased substantially in February and December 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in the Contractual Services – Legal.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: February 2011 included legal work performed related to the review of tariffs and discussions with customer service about billing "snowbirds".

December 2011 included legal work performed related to an inquiry from the attorney for the school board and drafting a service agreement for new schools. Total legal fees for the year were about \$75 per month on average. See attachment labeled "Contractual Services – Legal Invoices".

(c) Contractual Services- Mgmt. Fees increased substantially in December 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in the Contractual Services – Mgmt. Fees

<u>RESPONSE</u>: December 2011 included the quarterly allocation of corporate overhead costs across all utilities. The increase is due to an Audit adjustment that was recorded in order to correctly state the allocation for all of 2011. Please see Schedules G-1 and G-2 in the MFR for support of the corporate allocation.

(d) Contractual Services- Testing increased substantially from January 2011 to February 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in the Contractual Services – testing.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Contractual Services–Testing has a zero balance for each month of 2011 on B-5 and B-6.

(e) Contractual Services- Other increased substantially in February and July 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in the Contractual Services – other.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: February 2011 included bills for January and February. July 2011 included bills for July and August. See attachment labeled "Contractual Services – Other Invoices".

(f) Insurance – General Liability increased substantially in January and December 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in Insurance – General Liability.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Insurance expense was only recorded in January and December 2011. January included two months of expenses (January and February). The

average monthly amount was approximately 1/12th of the December amount. The Utility inadvertently did not make monthly entries for insurance expense throughout the year so a catch-up entry was completed in December. See attachment labeled "Insurance – General Liability Detail".

(g) Bad Debt Expense increased substantially in December 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in Bad Debt Expense. In Pluris' response to this request, please provide the Utility's bad debt expense accounts receivable write-off policy or procedures.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: At year-end 2011, in conjunction with the audit, we adjusted our Accounts Receivable subledger. In determining all viable Accounts Receivable, we implemented our policy that all accounts that were less than 90 days old were deemed collectible; therefore, all accounts greater than 90 days old would be written off to expense and reserved. This adjustment was a true-up for all of 2011.

(h) Miscellaneous Expenses increased substantially in July, September, November and December 2011 when compared to other months. Please provide all of the Utility's calculations, basis, work papers, and support documentation for the above increase in Miscellaneous Expenses.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: July 2011 included more bank charges (merchant fees and service charges) than typical due to volume. September 2011 included an invoice from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection for renewal of a license. November 2011 included more customer refunds than other months in 2011. December 2011 included an adjustment to correct a June credit as well as an Audit adjustment to reclassify the PST tax. See attached file labeled "Miscellaneous Expenses".

4. The Following Items relate to MFR Schedules B-7 and B-8.

(a) Contractual Services – Other, provide a copy of all invoices with an invoice amount of \$1,000 or greater.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoices labeled "Contractual Services – Other Invoices".

(b) Miscellaneous Expense, provide a copy of all invoices with an invoice amount of \$1,000 or greater.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: See attached invoice labeled "Miscellaneous Invoice".

5. The following questions are in regard to the MFR schedule E-5 page 1 of 2, Miscellaneous Service Charge Revenues.

(a) Online Payment Fee: The Utility indicated it received \$7,906 from an online payment fee. The Utility's current tariff does not authorize the collection of an online payment fee. In this regard, please provide the following:

i. Please indicate the amount of the online payment fee per transaction

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The online payment fee is \$2 per transaction.

ii. Does the Utility remit the payment to a third party vendor? If so, please prove the name of the third party vendor as well as the vendor's fee per transaction. Also, please describe in detail the transaction between the Utility and the third party vendor.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The Utility collected the payment from the customer and remited \$0.27/per transaction to Authorize.net. The vendor supplies the infrastructure and security necessary that allows customers to pay their utility bill online via Pluris' website.

iii. Please provide the number of online payment transactions for

the test year.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: There were 4,251 online payments for the test year.

iv. If the online payment fee is a Utility fee, please provide the cost justification for the online payment fee.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: With the development of a new website, the Utility has now discontinued the \$2.00 online fee for customer payment.

(b) Late Fees: The Utility indicated it collected late fees in the amount of \$29,056 from its residential customer class.

i. Please provide the number of bills late by system

<u>RESPONSE</u>: On average, there were approximately 300 - 350 customers per month with late penalties.

ii. Please provide the percentage of bills late to total bills by system

<u>RESPONSE</u>: On average, 300 - 350 customers were late of a total of 1580 billed which equates to approximately 20%.

iii. Also, does the Utility have any insight as to why it is experiencing its level of late payments? If so, please explain in detail.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: No, other than the general state of the economy.

(c) Miscellaneous Fees: The Utility collected miscellaneous fees in the amount of \$299. Please provide a detailed breakdown of this amount.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: This is mainly comprised of meter tampering. In 2011 there was not a bill code for meter tampering so it was coded to miscellaneous. The actual cost of repair to the meter was billed to the customer.

(d) Penalties: Please explain in detail why the utility has offset miscellaneous service revenues by penalties in the amount of \$12,595. Further, please provide a detailed breakdown of the penalties.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The debit of \$12,595 was a reversal of an entry that was originally recorded in 2010 for penalties charged to delinquent accounts. This reversal was recorded to miscellaneous service revenues and ultimately was included as part of the overall accounts receivable true-up for year-end 2011.

(e) Accruals: Please provide a detailed breakdown of the accruals.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: The \$968 of accruals is an estimate based off of prior months actuals due to the December billing reports not being completed as of 12/31/2011 (were completed in early January).

6. The following items relate to the Department of Environmental Protection

(DEP) Compliance Inspection Reports in MFR Volume III. Based on the 2011 inspection reports the wastewater treatment plant is currently out of compliance, please provide information pertaining to the following:

(a) Have non-compliance issues noted in both DEP Compliance Inspection Reports been corrected? If so, when, if not, why?

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Yes - All issues mentioned in the FDEP 2011 inspection report have been corrected. The giardia and cryptosporidium sampling, TSS issues and all issues for the ground water monitoring wells were completed. The inspection letter response is attached (labeled "Response letter 2011"). The weirs were replaced in June 2012.

(b) Has the wastewater treatment plant come into compliance with DEP? If so when, if not, why?

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Yes - The final item was the weirs and that was completed in June 2012.

7. The following item relates to the Detailed Maps in MFR Volume III.

(a) Please provide size, type and total length of pipe for both the water and wastewater collection systems.

RESPONSE: Water system - 2" to 8" - PVC & AC - approx. 92,342 feet. Wastewater system - 6" to 8" - PVC - approx. 92,342 feet.

Enclosed is an acceptance of project documentation for DEP Application Number 0080718-013-WC for the addition of a variable frequency drives to a high service pump, issued pursuant to Section 403.861(9), *Florida Statutes*.

The Department's proposed agency action shall become final unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the *Florida Statutes* before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the *Florida Statutes*. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received by the Clerk) with:

Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection Office of General Counsel 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35 Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3) of the *Florida Statutes* must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first.

Under Section 120.60(3) of the *Florida Statutes*, however, any person who has asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication.

The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57 of the *Florida Statutes*. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the *Florida Administrative Code*.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

- (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any; the Department permit identification number and the county in which the subject matter or activity is located;
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department action;
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department action;
- (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (e) A statement of facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department action;
- (f) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action that the petitioner wants the Department to take.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, *Florida Statutes*.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation under Section 120.573 of the Florida Statutes is not available for this proceeding.

This action is final and effective on the date filed with the Clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above. Upon the timely filing of a petition this order will not be effective until further order of the Department.

Any party to the order has the right to seek judicial review of the order under Section 120.68 of the *Florida Statutes*, by the filing of a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with:

NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE

The acceptance of this application is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, *Florida Statutes*, and Rule 62-555, *Florida Administrative Code*, (F.A.C.). Work has been performed as shown on the application and approved drawing, plans, and other documents attached hereto or on file with the Department and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

This project includes the removal of the existing deteriorated hydropneumatic tank on April 26, 2012 and the addition of a 100 HP Alvitar 61 Model No. ATV61HD75N4 variable frequency drive (VFD) to High Service Pump No. 3 at the Wedgefield Water Treatment Plant. The VFD was put into service on April 25, 2012.

According to the applicant, VFDs were already placed on high service pump Nos. 2 and 4 when a 5year compliance inspection of the tank was conducted. These VFDs are Altivar 61, Model No. ATV61HD22H4, 30 HP, 480 Volt (HSP No. 2) and Altivar 61, Model No. ATV61HD37N4, 50 HP, 480 Volt (HSP No. 4), respectively. This document will memorialize these two VFDs in addition to the one added by the applicant. The purpose of these VFDs is to regulate pressure in the distribution system piping. The capacity of the water treatment plant did not change as a result of this addition.

This document does not pertain to any wastewater, stormwater or dredge and fill aspects of the project. This acceptance is issued based upon the dates and submissions during the application process as follows: construction plans, calculations, and correspondence received on June 29, 2012 and June 21, 2012.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations and restrictions set forth in this permit, are "permit conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.141, 403.727, or 403.859 through 403.861, F.S. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violations of these conditions.
- This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
- 3. As provided in subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state, or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in this permit.
- 4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgment of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
- 5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
- 6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed and used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, as required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.
- 7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at reasonable times, access to the premises where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:
 - a) Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under conditions of the permit;
 - Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
 - c) Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

- 8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any conditions or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:
 - a) A description of and cause of noncompliance; and
 - b) The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the noncompliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

- 9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Section 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.
- 10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and Florida Statutes after a reasonable time for compliance; provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or Department rules.
- 11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rule 62-4.120 and 62-30.300, F.A.C., as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.
- 12. This permit or a copy thereof shall be kept at the work site of the permitted activity.
- 13. The permittee shall comply with the following:
 - a) Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.
 - b) The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.
 - c) Records of monitoring information shall include:
 - 1. The date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
 - 2. The person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
 - 3. The date analyses were performed;
 - 4. The person responsible for performing the analyses;
 - 5. The analytical techniques or methods used;
 - 6. The results of such analyses.

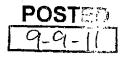

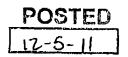

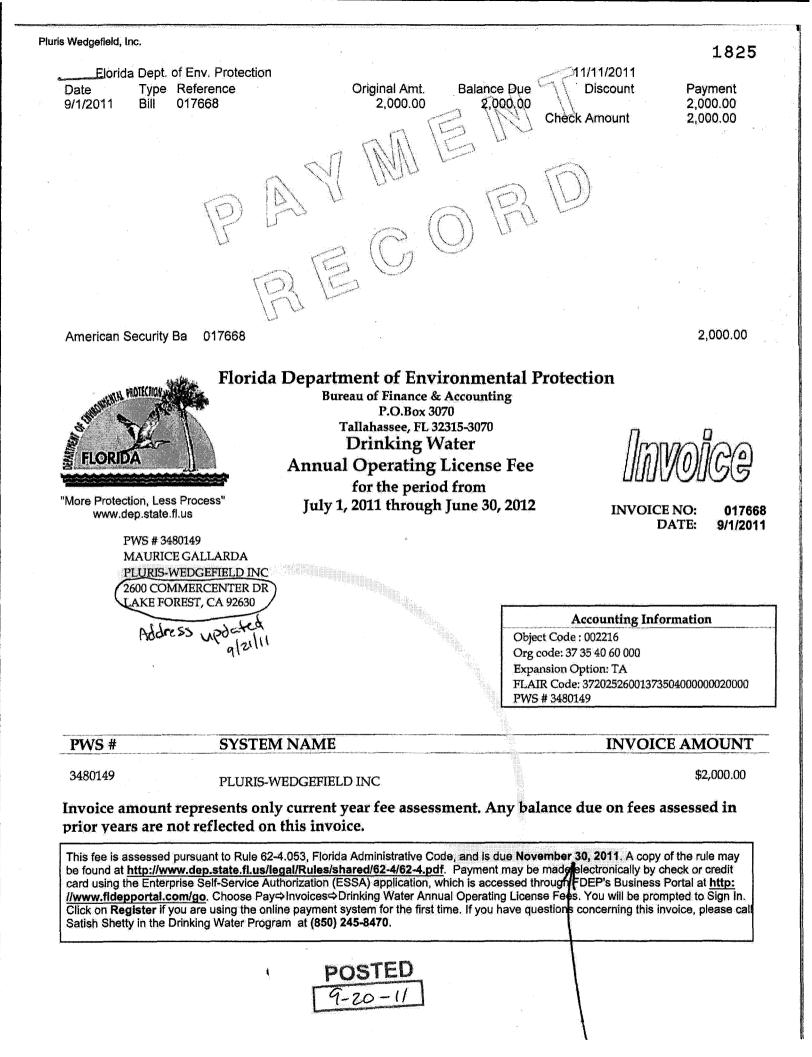

t am writing on behalf of Pluris Wedgefield, Inc., the owner of the above referenced facility. This letter is in response to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection letter dated December 2, 2011. I would like to address the items in order of your letter, and numbered as presented on the Inspection Report, dated September 27, 2011.

Inspection conducted on August 9, 2011:

5.1) Records and Reports. Giardia and Cryptosporidium has not been tested within the past five years as required by permit Condition I.A.9.

The last test result was submitted in April of 2005. We regret not taking this required sampling earlier in the year. We have Lab scheduled to be on-site to perform the sampling on Monday, December 19, 2011. We will forward to your office the results as soon as we receive them from the lab.

6.10) Facility Site Review. The weirs in the east plant were providing very uneven flow, with some possible short-circuiting apparent. The surface of the east clarifier was covered with floating solids.

We are currently seeking proposals to correct the weirs in the east clarifier. We request ninety (90) days to complete these repairs.

The floating solids in the east clarifier were attributable to Red Worms as Roger explained during your inspection. We applied two applications of AquaBac XT in July and August of 2011 to remove them. The clarifier was clear within a week of this visit, and the red worms are gone. Since the was no mention of east clarifier on the Inspection of November 10, 2001, this issue has been resolved.

7.1) Flow Measurement. No staff gauge present at the effluent flow meter.

The staff gauge was installed on December 1, 2011.

12.1) Groundwater Quality. The pH measurements were not provided for all locations for the second quarter of 2010. The nitrate and TDS results for groundwater samples from well MWC-2 were not reported correctly. The groundwater elevation was not reported for well MW-1R for the third quarter of 2010. Top of casing and ground surface elevations were not provided for Piezometers P-1 and P-2.

All of these reports have been revised, and are attached to this letter for your records.

Subsequent Inspection conducted on November 10, 2011.

5.1) Records and Reports, and 12.0) Effluent Quality. Both mention January and February of 2011 which exceeded the maximum Total Suspended Solids level. Both were not reported to the Department within 24 hours of discovery.

The January 2011 exceedance was noted as a possible lab error due to the recorded Turbidity at sampling being 1.7 NTUs .

The February 2011 exceedance was noted as a sample was taken by the operator at the time the filters were backwashing, and the recorded Turbidity level at the time of sampling was 2.7 NTUs.

Staff has been informed that this reporting criteria is crucial to our permit, and will not be tolerated in the future. We have also contacted the lab to email us any and all exceedances going forward versus awaiting sample results through the mail in order to report these items in a timelier manner to the Department.
