On January 29, 2013, Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula) filed a Request for Confidential Classification (Request) for information contained in its response to Staff's First Data Request, Item No. 6 and Attachment 2 (DN 00579-13). The Request states that Peninsula treats this information as proprietary confidential business information consistent with the definition of that term in Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes and the amounts identified, if disclosed, would enable a competitor to back into confidential contractual data.

After reviewing the above referenced document, staff agrees that disclosure of the redacted information could harm the Company's ability to effectively negotiate for goods and services; therefore, staff recommends the request be granted.
