On February 12, 2013, pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F. S.), Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (PEF) filed a request for confidential classification with respect to the highlighted information contained in Document Number 00822-13: Treasury Risk Management Guidelines and Policy ACT-SUBS-00074. PEF states that the information contained in these documents should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 366.093(3) (e), F.S.

PEF requests confidentiality under Subsection 366.093(1) F.S., which states:

- (3) Proprietary confidential business information means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers for the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. Proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to:
  - (g) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Upon review of the aforementioned documents, staff concurs with FPL that the highlighted information contained in Document Number 00822-13 meets the requirements for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(1), (3)(d) and (4). Accordingly, this information should be treated as confidential.
